**JORDANIAN DELEGATION PAYS COURTESY CALL ON  
DEPUTY FORCE COMMANDER**

*Freetown* – A four-member Jordanian delegation led by Maj. Gen. Ahmed Ali Did yesterday paid a courtesy call on the Deputy Force Commander of the United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL), Maj. Gen. Martin L. Agwai. The delegation is on a four-day visit to Sierra Leone to observe the work of the Jordanian medical team serving with UNAMSIL.

In his welcome remarks to the delegation, the Deputy Force Commander expressed UNAMSIL's gratitude to the Government of Jordan for its contribution to the peace process in Sierra Leone, adding that the comportment of the Jordanian peacekeepers in the Mission has been exemplary.

The delegation leader conveyed the gratitude of the Chief of Staff of the Jordanian Army to the Deputy Force Commander. He also thanked UNAMSIL for its role in bringing peace to the country.

Meanwhile, another delegation from Zambia is visiting the country to attend the ceremonial burial of two Zambian peacekeepers who, along with four Ukrainian crew members, were killed in a UNAMSIL helicopter crash off the coast of Freetown on 7 November 2001. The delegation will attend a ceremony at sea today for the deceased whose bodies were not recovered.
