EXECUTIVE

President: Ahmad Tejan Kabbah (SLPP)

Vice President: Dr. Albert Joe Demby (SLPP)

The president is elected for a five-year term. President Kabbah's term of office was interrupted by the civil war when rebels took the capital. The government is formed by the SLPP, PDP, DCP and the rebel movement Armed Forces Revolutionary Council.
