# Supplementary Protocol to the Exchange of notes constituting an agreement concerning the delimitation of the borderline between Denmark and the Federal Republic of Germany in the Flensborg Fiord area. Signed at Flensburg on 25 August 1971 and at Abenra on 14 September 1971(1)

Pursuant to agreement between the Parties (Note Verbale of the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany at Copenhagen of 22 October 1970, No. IA5-82.00, and the note in reply of the Danish Foreign Ministry, of 28 October 1970, No. RI7B70.a), it was decided to relocate the border in the Flensborg Fiord from the old Holnaes (Holnis) lighthouse to the new Holnaes (Holnis) lighthouse.

In execution of this Agreement, the positions of border beacons 4a and 9a were determined and the beacons were repositioned on the new border line; the positions of frontier points I and E were redetermined. The measurement data and calculations were transmitted in triplicate in letters dated 17 March 1971 and 14 May 1971, No. 1700, to the District surveyor, Mr. Andersen in Abenra (Apenrade) for verification and information.

The positions of the new beacons 4a and 9a and of the new frontier points I and E are acknowledged as binding by both parties.
