

**Ad Hoc Open-ended Informal Working Group to study issues relating to  
the conservation and sustainable use of marine biological diversity  
beyond areas of national jurisdiction**

**1 to 4 April 2014  
UNHQ, New York**

In resolution 68/70, paragraph 200, the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to convene three meetings of the Ad Hoc Open-ended Informal Working Group to study issues relating to the conservation and sustainable use of marine biological diversity beyond areas of national jurisdiction, to take place from 1 to 4 April and 16 to 19 June 2014 and from 20 to 23 January 2015.

As a result, the seventh meeting of the Ad Hoc Open-ended Informal Working Group will take place from 1 to 4 April 2014, at United Nations Headquarters in New York.

**Invitations**

Invitations to the meeting were sent in December 2013 to all States Members of the United Nations and all parties to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, as well as to entities that have received a standing invitation to participate as observers in the work of the General Assembly pursuant to its relevant resolutions, competent specialized agencies, funds and programmes of the United Nations, other competent intergovernmental organizations, and relevant non-governmental organizations.
