The United Nations Mission in Sudan (UNMIS) hereby solicits Expression of Interest (EOI) from competent companies for the requirements stated herein.

Description of General Requirements

- Construction of natural gravel compacted roads over compacted sub-base soil and installation of culverts for drainage.
- The internal roads required are: (i) 22-metre width (24,420 m²); (ii) 12-metre width (78,000 m²); and (iii) 8-metre width (32,400 m²).
