DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

1.0 United Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq (UNAMI) intends to solicit bids for the supply, delivery and servicing of one (1) Mine Protected Armoured Ambulance, B6 NATO Ballistic Protection, LHD, Liquid Cool Direct Injection, Four Stroke, 6 Cylinder Diesel, Five Speed Automatic, One reverse, , RG-31 Mine Protected Ambulance (MPA) suitable for both on and off road, colour white, Vehicle System Medical Compartment, Remote System Medical Compartment (External Power Source), Vehicle System Driver's Cab, Medical Compartment Climate Control.

Medical Equipments:- Adult Resuscitator, Cervical Collar, Spine Board, Half Spine Board, Spider Harness, Med-Splint Leg, Medi-Splint Arm, Suction Unit, Traction Splint Adult, Defib Gel, Scoop Stretcher, Immobilization Device Head, Extrication Device, Zip Stretcher, Road Cones, BLS Jumb Bag including spare parts packages, specialized tool kit, technical manuals and spare parts catalogue, Two years regular (post warranty) maintenance service in the International Zone, Baghdad, Iraq to be provided as per the manufacturer's standards and to include Armoured related services and all required spares and consumables.

2.0 For this purpose, UNAMI will undertake a competitive bidding exercise shortly, accordingly would issue a Request For Proposal (RFP) to those companies who would express their interest and provide initial relevant information confirming their capability to meet the EOI prequalification criteria and fulfil UNAMI's requirement.

3.0 MANDATORY PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

- i. Capability to Supply, Delivery and Servicing of One Mine Protected Armoured Ambulance with B6 NATO Ballistic protection to DDU-UNAMI Headquarters – Kuwait (Incoterms 2000).
- ii. Capability to provide pre-delivery inspection, commissioning, warranty and post-warranty maintenance/repair services, technical manuals, spare parts catalogues, special tools and genuine spare

parts in Baghdad (International Zone), Iraq, and in accordance with the manufacturer's standards.

- iii. Availability of an authorized maintenance/repair service center in Baghdad (International Zone), Iraq
- iv. Capability to provide 10% of Contract price as a Performance Bond.
- v. Business presence in the Country
- vi. Duly completed UNAMI or UNPS/UNGM Vendor Registration Formalities.
- vii. Duly completed and signed Vendor Response Form.
