I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter (S/AC.39/2001/OC.18) of 12 April 2001 wherein you called our attention to Security Council resolution 1343 (2001) and in particular paragraph 2 (a).

The Government of the Republic of Liberia wishes to inform you that none of the individuals named on the attached list (see enclosure) were present in the territory of Liberia at the time of the adoption of resolution 1343 (2001) and none of them have ever been in Liberia subsequent thereto. Those known to us are individuals whose current whereabouts are reported to be in Sierra Leone where they are engaged in constant interaction with the United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL) and the Sierra Leone Government. Among these are Issa Sessay (alias General Emperor), Gibril Massaquoi (Colonel Postmaster/Wild Fire) and Omrie Golley who is chairman of the new chief council and official spokesman of the Revolutionary United Front (RUF). Mr. Omrie Golley, we understand, lives in Europe, which is known to UNAMSIL.

Concerning the others, the Government cannot understand how Ibrahim Bah, who is alleged in the United Nations list to be President Campaore's adviser on RUF, can serve in that capacity while residing in Liberia. While we recognize the name of Mr. Sam "Mosquito" Bockariue as former military commander of RUF who was exiled in Liberia for awhile in consequence of arrangements with the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) and the United Nations, he left this country prior to the adoption of Security Council resolution 1343 (2001) as a result of Liberia's decision to disengage from the Sierra Leonean peace process and its expulsion order to all RUF members. The other individuals on the list are not known to the Government of Liberia.

Kindly circulate the present document as a document of the Security Council.
