INTRODUCTION

Hello everybody! Welcome to the 3PLUS-U web site.

Click on **START** and let our three hosts, Toshi, Kaia and Isabelle introduce you to the site and lead you into their treehouse. Once you are there, you can explore the issues of the International Labour Organisation's Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work.

TREEHOUSE

Here we are in the 3Plus-U treehouse with our friends Toshi, Kaia and Isabelle. Read the sidebar on the left for some instructions on how to go through the site. Once you have read it, *Click* the **CLOSE** button on the sidebar's upper right hand corner to **CLOSE** the sidebar. Now we can really start exploring!

Move your mouse around the screen and over Toshi, Kaia and Isabelle. Each of them will give you a personal greeting! Do you know what languages each of them are speaking? While you pass your cursor over either of the friends, descriptions of each of them will popup on the bottom half of the screen. *Click* on each of the three friends to find out more about which issues each of them are researching and to find out what sort of adventures they have in store for you.

When you *Click* on Toshi, Kaia or Isabelle a menu box will appear. Next to the pictures you'll find a small list of each of their sections. *Click* on each section to see more information on what is in those sections. When you've decided where you want to go or who you want to explore with, then *Click* on the **START** button or the little picture. If you want to choose another friend, *Click* **CLOSE** on the menu box.

In Toshi, Kaia and Isabelle's sections there are several options which you always have available. At the top right hand side of the website, *Click* on the question mark (?) button reveals a **HELP** menu with a list of several options. You can use the **HELP** menu to move to different sections of the website. You'll also find some very useful tools here to help you better understand the site: the **GLOSSARY OF TERMS**, which defines some of the more difficult words you might come across; the **SITE GUIDE**, which provides instructions on how to use the site; the **SITE CONTENT**, providing the full text of the website in pdf format, and; a **GUIDE FOR TEACHERS**.

TOSHI'S ADVENTURE

Welcome to Toshi's Adventure! Once you've read Toshi's introduction, *Click* on the **CLOSE** button. Then move your cursor over the landscape, the map in his hands, the maps in his backpack or the game controller to access his different sections. *Click* on different parts of this page will take you to four different sections: *Click* on the **LANDSCAPE** in front of Toshi to visit the Our World section; *Click* his **MAP** to go to the Working Together section; *Click* the **GAME CONTROLLER** to take you to the challenge section; and when you move your cursor over Toshi's backpack, you'll have the choice of *Clicking* into one of four different **SUPPLY CHAINS**: Toys, Chocolate, Footballs and Apparel. If you want to go back to the **TREEHOUSE** to explore the other characters, you can *Click* on the **ARROW** button on the bottom left hand side of your screen.

OUR WORLD

Here we are in the 'Our World' section. Look at the different places you can visit. Does anything look familiar? There are three particular types of places here: the **FARM**, the **TOWN** and the **INDUSTRIAL** area. Dragging your cursor over the picture will highlight the different places and *Clicking* on them will take you into that part of the picture.

THE INDUSTRIAL AREA

Look at all the buildings, factories and people around you! There are a lot of issues relevant to this industrial area. This place has five objects, each with its own story that you can find. Do you think you can find them all? Drag your cursor around the picture and those objects you find will start to **GLOW**. *Click* those **GLOWING** objects to find out their stories! Here's a hint: the five stories are discrimination, workers' organizations, soccer balls, factory workers and freedom of association. As you find them, they will appear as boxes in the bottom part of the screen. At the top of the screen you can see how many objects you still have to find.

FARM

Life on the farm looks a little more relaxed than in the city, but there are a lot of important issues here too. Five objects in this picture have stories to them, drag your cursor around the picture and those objects you find will start to **GLOW**. *Click* those **GLOWING** objects to find out their stories! The five stories are child labour, forced labour, hats, tractors and farmers. As you *Select* them, they will appear as boxes in the bottom part of the screen. At the top of the scene you can see how many objects you still have to find.

TOWN

Do you live in a town like this? There are six objects to find in this scene. Drag your cursor around the picture and those objects you find will start to **GLOW**. *Click* those **GLOWING** objects to find out their stories! The six stories are about the storekeeper, paper boy, bicycle, shirt, the store front and flowers. As you *Select* them, they will appear as boxes in the bottom part of the screen. At the top of the scene you can see how many objects you still have to find.

WORKING TOGETHER

This is the map that Toshi is studying at the moment, with the whole world before us. You can *Click* on the **ORANGE DOTS** to learn more about the different countries, the issues and problems that they face and the work which the ILO and others are doing to solve those problems. There are six **ORANGE DOTS**, have you *Clicked* on all of them? They relate to the countries of El Salvador in Latin America, Romania in Europe, Tanzania in Africa, and India, Nepal and Cambodia in Asia. To get back to Toshi's main page, *Click* on the '**MORE WITH TOSHI**' arrow on the bottom left hand side of the screen.

CHALLENGE

Ready to be challenged? *Click* on the flashing arrow on the left side of the screen to start the game. When the questions come up, try to find out which answer is correct and *Click* on the **RED BUTTON** that corresponds to the answer you think is correct. Some of the answers don't fit into their little boxes, but you can expand them by *Clicking* on the boxes themselves. If the answer is correct the **GREEN LIGHT** on the top of the game controller will flash, if its wrong then the red light will flash... hopefully that won't happen too often.

After every five questions, you will see how well you're doing, how many questions you answered correctly and how many you still need to learn about. Once you've answered all fifteen questions from the three levels you will receive your score. If it is high enough then you'll be able to download a prize: a **CERTIFICATE** which you can *Print* out and share with your friends and family. At any point during the challenge you can return to Toshi's section by clicking the back button on the bottom left hand side of the screen.

SUPPLY CHAINS

There are four **SUPPLY CHAINS** that you can *Click* into through Toshi's backpack. They explore the production processes of Toys, Chocolate, Footballs and Apparel. In each of these **SUPPLY CHAINS**, the production cycle will be displayed on the right hand of the screen, while the parts of the process are described in detail on the left hand side of the screen. You can navigate through the production process by *Clicking* on the different boxes, which represent steps in the **SUPPLY CHAINS**. As you do this, the detailed texts on the left will change to describe the step in the chain that you've chosen. Some steps in the chain have lightbulb icons and numbers next to them. This means that there are interesting issues linked with this particular step in the chain. The numbers can be *Clicked* and will reveal

more information about those issues. To leave these sections and return to Toshi's main page, click the **BACK** arrow on the bottom left hand side of the page.

KAIA'S LIBRARY

Look at all the books that Kaia has in her library! Once you've read her introduction, *Click* on the **CLOSE** button on the top right hand side of the box. Get ready to look over Kaia's shoulder at some of those books. Move your cursor over Kaia's books. Once you've decided which section you want to visit, *Click* on the **BOOK** it corresponds to. If you want to go back to the **TREEHOUSE** to explore the other characters, you can click on the **ARROW** button on the bottom left hand side of your screen.

WHAT CAN I DO?

Did you open to the 'What Can I Do?' page as well? This section looks at what other kids are doing to promote decent work worldwide. Maybe you can get some ideas.

You can see that Kaia has been through this book already, look at all the **YELLOW MARKERS** she's stuck to her favorite sections! *Click* on the **YELLOW MARKERS** to flip to those sections. Some of these sections are longer than the two pages that you flip to, so make sure that you don't miss anything. If a story continues past the two pages, then an **ARROW** appears on the page when you move your cursor over it. *Clicking* on the page will turn to the next page. Don't miss any **YELLOW MARKERS**, there are seven in this book!

JUST LIKE ME

This is the **JUST LIKE ME** book, and in here you can read about the real life stories of children and grown-ups whose lives have been affected by child labour, forced labour, discrimination and freedom of association. Kaia has been through this **BOOK** as well, and there are nine **YELLOW MARKERS** notes stuck to different pages of the book. *Click* on the **YELLOW MARKERS** to flip to those sections. Some of these sections are longer than the two pages that you flip to, so make sure that you don't miss anything. If a story continues past the two pages, then an **ARROW** appears on the page when you move your cursor over it. *Clicking* on the page will turn to the next page. Make sure you don't miss any of the sections!

ISABELLE'S COMPUTER

Isabelle has a really high-tech computer system set up in the **TREEHOUSE**. Once you've read her introduction, *Click* on the **CLOSE** button on the top right hand side of the box and then let's log in with her. Move your cursor over the **COMPUTER** so that it flashes, then *Click* to enter the **COMPUTER** network. If you want to go back to the **TREEHOUSE** to explore the other characters, you can *Click* on the **ARROW** button on the bottom left hand corner of your screen.

Login

Click on the **NAME BOX** and *Type* your name. Then *Click* on the **BEGIN** button - or just press *Enter*. If you don't want to go further, you can *Click* on the **LOGOUT AND EXIT DATABASE** arrow on the bottom left hand side of the screen.

ILO'S DATABASE

Welcome to the ILO's database. On the left you'll be able to find 3 different categories to surf. *Click* on the **WHY?**, **DID YOU KNOW?**, and **LINKS AND RESOURCES** buttons to bring them up.

WHY?

The 'Why?' page explores some key questions about the ILO Declaration and also has the exact text of the Declaration for you to look at. You can access the 'Why is there an ILO Declaration?', 'Why was the ILO created?' and 'the Declaration' text by *Clicking* on the buttons on the top part of the screen. To close this page *Click* on the little **X** on the top right hand corner of the page. You can minimize or maximize the pages as well by *Clicking* on the **+** and **-** buttons in the same place. To exit the database back to the Isabelle's main page, *Click* on the **LOGOUT AND EXIT DATABASE** arrow on the bottom left hand side of the page.

DID YOU KNOW?

This section will provide you with all sorts of new facts about the world of work, the problems people face and what is being done about it. *Click* on the **PROCEED** button to move from the **INTRODUCTION** page to a **MAP** of the world. As you move your cursor over different parts of the **MAP**, some of the **BOXES** will darken and reveal a little fact. *Click* on these boxes to learn more about the fact. Text will pop-up to cover the whole screen. Once you've read it, it can be closed by *Clicking* the **CLOSE** button on

the top left hand corner of the screen. Doing this will take you back to the **MAP** and then you can explore other facts concerning the four fundamental principles and rights at work. Make sure you read all of them - there are nine!

LINKS AND RESOURCES

Want to find out more about the issues you have explored with Toshi, Kaia and Isabelle? On this part of the website you can find a resource of internet links to other interesting websites. *Click* on the + button on the top right hand corner of the text box to maximize the window. There are five different types of websites that you can find here: general websites and websites that focus on child labour, forced labour, freedom of association, and discrimination. *Click* on the subject that interests you and the links will show on the right side of the screen. *Click* on the **LINK** buttons to visit the website that most interests you.
