Additional Protocol to the Agreement of 18 December 1995 between the Kingdom of Norway and the Kingdom of Denmark concerning the Delimitation of the Continental Shelf in the Area between Jan Mayen and Greenland and the Boundary between the Fishery Zones in the Area:

The demarcation line between the Parties' parts of the continental shelf and between the fishery zones in the area shall include a straight geodetic line between the following points:

The above-mentioned points are defined by their geographical latitude and longitude in accordance with the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS 84)

Delimitation Line between Jan Mayen and Iceland as established in Additional Protocol to the Agreement of 8 May 1980 between Norway and Iceland concerning Fishery and Continental Shelf Questions and the Agreement derived therefrom of 22 October 1981 on the Continental Shelf between Jan Mayen and Iceland

The demarcation line between the Parties' parts of the continental shelf and between the fishery zones in the area shall include a straight geodetic line between the following points:

Point 1: 69° 35' 00" N 13° 16' 00" W Point 2: 69° 34' 42" N 12° 09' 24" W
