

**Instructions for Applicants to the
United Nations – The Nippon Foundation of Japan Fellowship Programme**

A. The application package consists of three forms:

1. The *Personal History and Proposed Research/Study Programme Form*

Form should be completed by the candidate, either typewritten or word processed. Each question must be answered clearly and completely in order to ensure that the application will be processed. If necessary, pages of the same size may be attached.

2. The *Nomination and Recommendation Form*

Form to be completed by a responsible official of the nominating Government, institution or other body who must forward the completed form directly to the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea (DOALOS).

3. The *UN Medical Form*

To be completed by a medical doctor and forwarded to DOALOS with the Personal History and Proposed Research/Study Programme Form. All fields must be completed by the attending doctor. The original results from the laboratory tests performed under the “Laboratory” section of the form must also be annexed to the form, and the X-rays must also be included with the application forms.

C. Original completed applications (3 forms, original laboratory reports, and x-rays) must be returned to DOALOS (Attn: UN-Nippon Fellowship Programme Advisor) by the established deadline.

Application may be faxed (+1-212-963-5847), but all originals and attachments must be mailed (The UN-Nippon Fellowship Programme Advisor, Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, Office of Legal Affairs, Room DC2-0450, United Nations, New York, N.Y. 10017, U.S.A.) in order for the application to be considered complete.

D. DOALOS reserves the right not to process incomplete and/or late submissions.
