**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF
INTEREST**

Subject: Short-Term Passenger Aircraft Charter

The Procurement Division of the United Nations contracts with aircraft operators on a short term basis for the provision of chartered passenger flights for transportation of UN peace keeping troop contingents, in support of the UN peace-keeping operations around the world. A typical requirement in this category is the passenger airlift for the rotation, deployment and repatriation of troop contingents with 45/100 kg per passenger of personal baggage, from a UN member state to a peace-keeping mission, and often rotating the preceding contingent back to their home country on the return leg.

The intent of this EOI notice is to encourage experienced, reputable Operators of the passenger jet aircraft to apply for registration as a UN vendor so that they can be invited to bid in such solicitations. For aircraft operators, the vendor registration process is in two parts: corporate/financial and technical/operational. Both need to be completed. For the technical/operational application, which is required to be accompanied by copy of A.O.C, C.O.R, C.O.A, and manuals such as Company Operations Manual in accordance with ICAO Annex 6, please click [here](#).

Certificates and manuals must conform to the convention on International Civil Aviation and instruments issued thereunder, and must be accompanied by an English language translation. All copies submitted should be "Certified True Copies" by an appropriate certifying authority.
