Barriers to leadership and participation

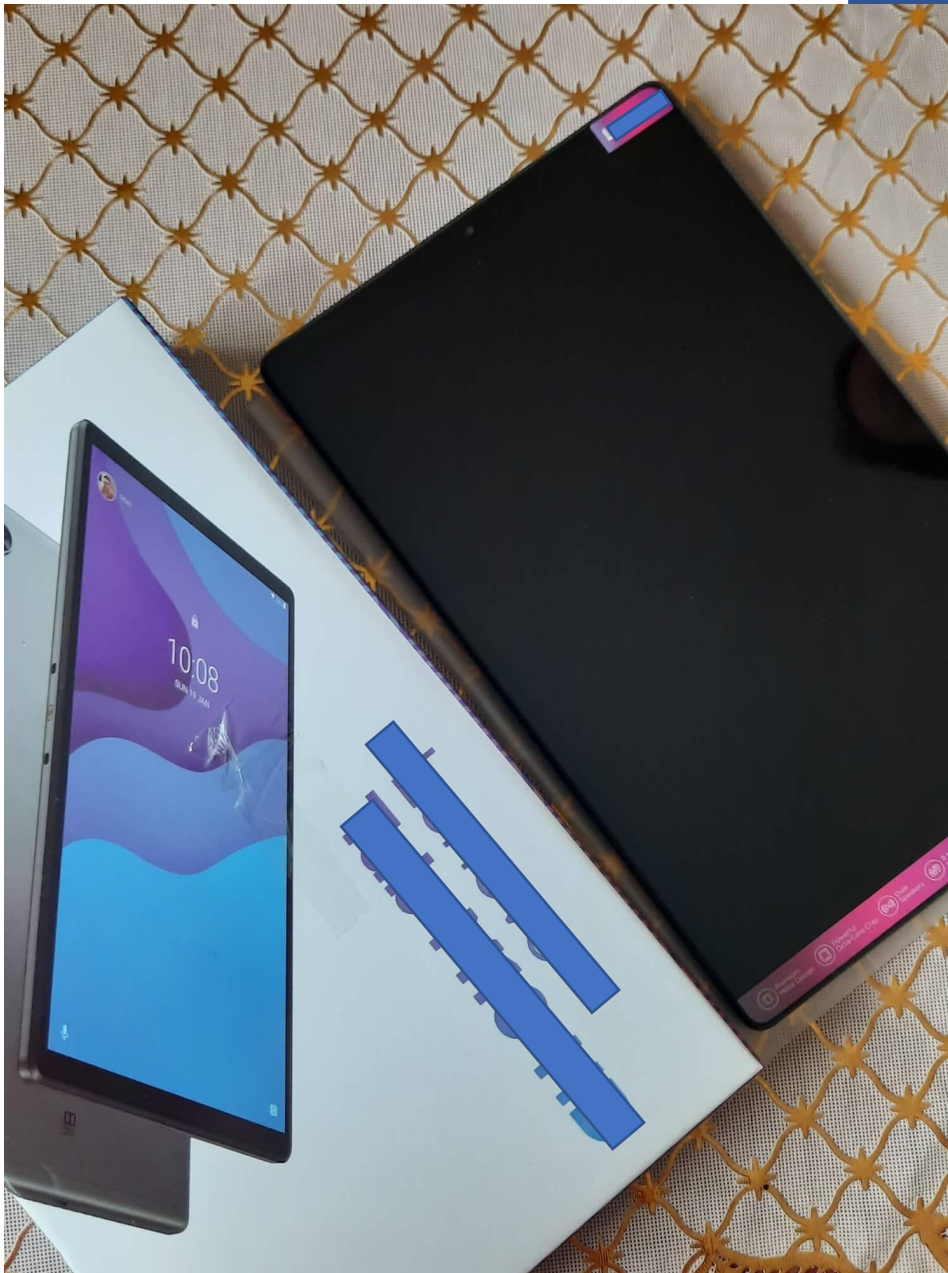
Limited resources of OPDs
