The Permanent Mission of Greece to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Office for Disarmament Affairs of the United Nations and with reference to the latter's Note, ODA/24-2008/NLDU dated 14 March 2008, has the honour to provide the following information:

a. National Law 2168/93 regulates issues regarding arms, ammunition, explosive ordnance and devices.

b. Ministerial Gazette 248630/13 July 2006/MOD describes the specific procedures and documents that must be submitted by the importers/exporters to The Ministry of National Defence/General Directorate of Armaments and Investments/Department of International Relations, in order to get the import/export license.

c. Ministerial Gazette 125695/E3/5695 refers to the transfer control of dual-use goods.

d. Ministerial Gazette 733 (Φ600/311054/S.572) refers to the function and control of Greek Defence Industry producing or repairing arms, ammunition or other war material, and the documents – procedures required for issuing licenses of manufacture, disposal and transport.
