#### **I. Introduction**

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2001, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-sixth session the item entitled:

“Sustainable development and international economic cooperation:

“(a) Women in development;

“(b) Human resources development;

“(c) High-level dialogue on strengthening international economic cooperation for development through partnership;

“(d) Implementation of the commitments and policies agreed upon in the Declaration on International Economic Cooperation, in particular the Revitalization of Economic Growth and Development of the Developing Countries, and implementation of the International Development Strategy for the Fourth United Nations Development Decade”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee held a substantive debate on the item at its 24th and 25th meetings, on 6 November 2001. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/56/SR.24 and 25).
