Appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2001, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-sixth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions”.
2. At its 22nd meeting, on 2 November 2001, the Fifth Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/56/102) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of six of its members on 31 December 2001.
3. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/56/6) containing the names of six persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2002.
4. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Henry Siegfried Fox (Australia), Bernardo Greiver (Uruguay), Hassan Mohammed Hassan (Nigeria), Eduardo Iglesias (Argentina), Omar Kadiri (Morocco) and Eduardo Manuel da Fonseca Fernandes Ramos (Portugal) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2002 (see para. 5).
