The decrease of \$118,700 relates mainly to residential security measures, since most of the staff live in apartments where security is being provided and therefore are not entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred in hiring private security guards.

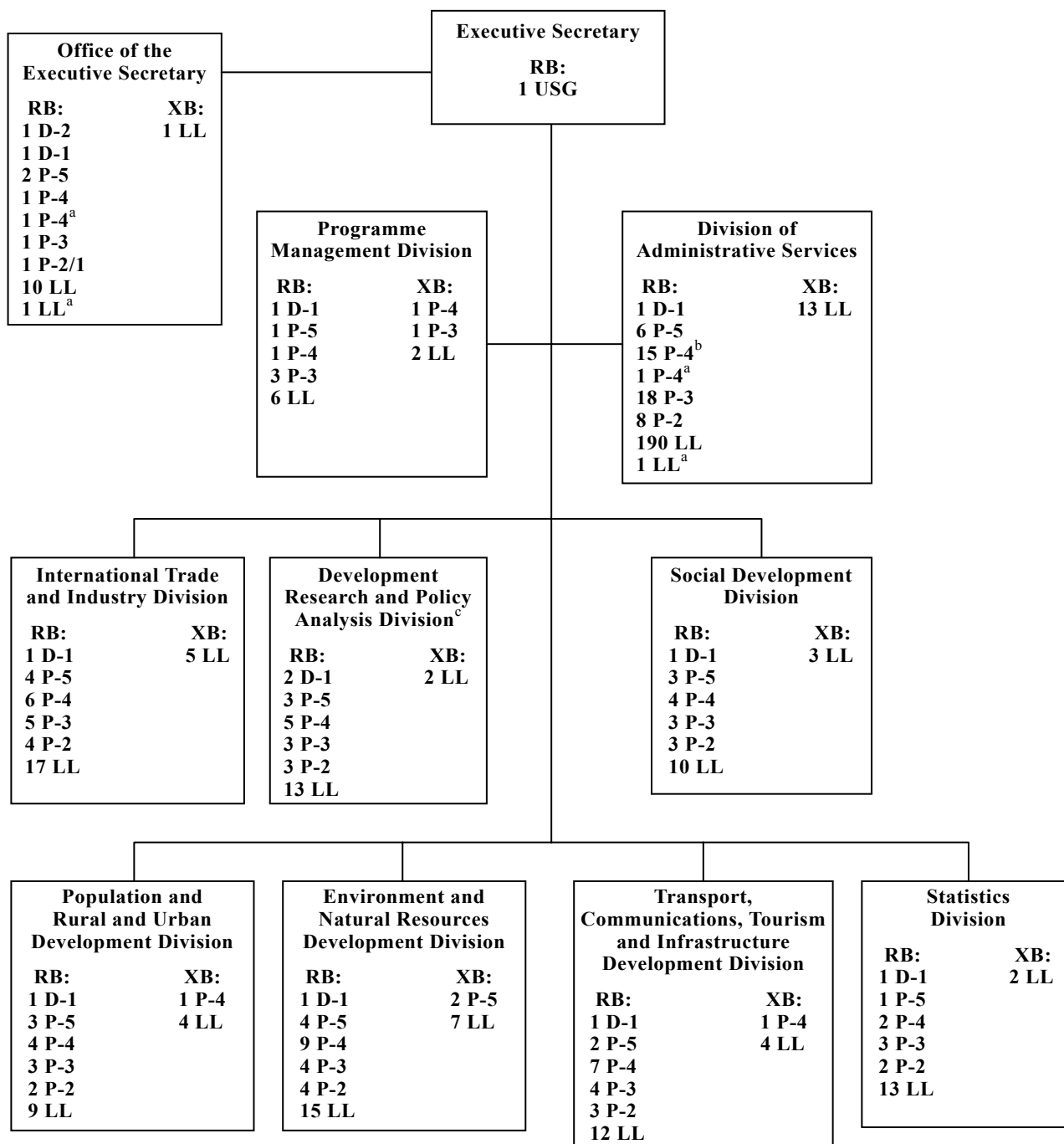

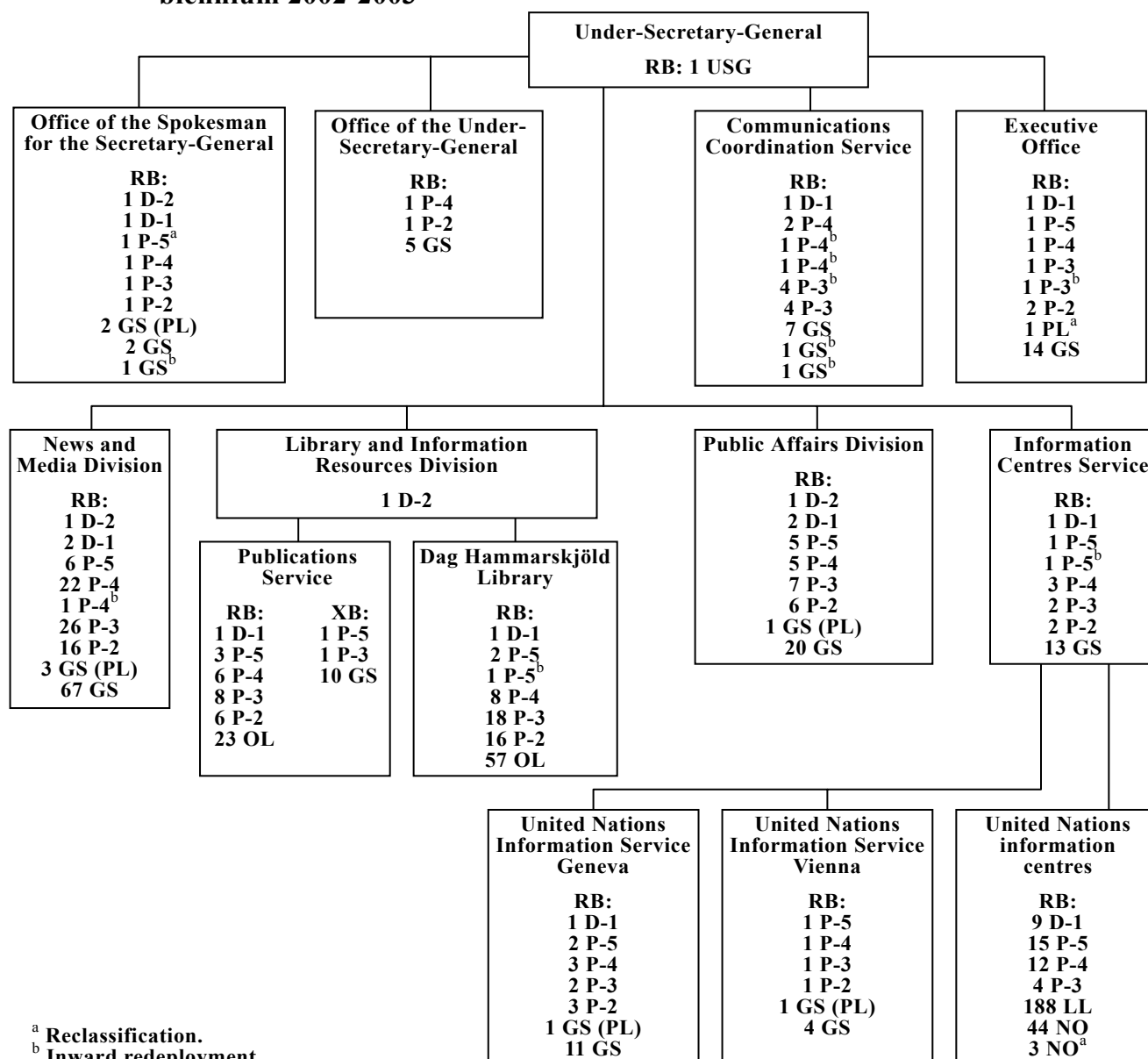
