Listing as a Non-Self-Governing Territory

The **Turks and Caicos Islands** has been on the United Nations list of Non-Self-Governing Territories since 1946, following the transmission of information on **Jamaica** (under which the Turks and Caicos had fallen) by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland under Article 73 *e* of the Charter of the United Nations.
