Social Accounting Matrix

- The basic accounting structure and much of the underlying data of MAMS is derived from a Social Accounting Matrix
 - base year is 2009
- A MAMS SAM has unconventional features related to
 - explicit treatment of financial flows
 - detailed disaggregation of sectors for MDG- and education-related services.

Steps in the Uganda SAM Building Process

- 1. Construction of a MacroSAM
 - national accounts, government budget, and the balance of payments
- 2. Disaggregation of the MacroSAM into a matrix with a large sectoral breakdown (MicroSAM) suitable for the calibration of MAMS
 - use data in MacroSAM as control totals
 - disaggregate accounts for activities, commodities, factors, institutions
- 3. Adaptation of the MicroSAM to make it suitable for the calibration of MAMS
 - additional disaggregations

- The main sources of information were
 - national accounts
 - balance of payments
 - government data
 - budget and recurrent incomes and expenditures
 - supply and use tables
 - sectoral GDP for the year 2009
 - intermediate consumption and value added with reasonable sectoral disaggregation; necessary to update the supply and use tables
