



Summary, next steps, timeline

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First intensive training workshop on "Strengthening Macro-Micro Modelling Capacities to Assess Development Support Measures and Strategies in Uganda", Entebbe, 7-9 March, 2012.

Revisiting workshop objectives

- Describe the MAMS in detail.
- Take stock of data availability, present a recently updated dataset for MAMS for Uganda (including a newly updated Social Accounting Matrix), and agree on future data collection.
- Describe the Excel-based interface known as ISIM-MAMS.
- Conduct practical sessions to explain the use of ISIM-MAMS.
- Undertake practical sessions to conduct policy simulations in three (interrelated) blocks: exogenous policy and external shocks, support measures and achievement of human development goals (left for next workshop).
- Revisit the timeline and agree on newly-revised deadlines (if needed).

Key questions

- Will reform policies recommended in previous MDG analysis (or redefined MDG strategies) be feasible if:
 - there is a global economic crisis?
 - Uganda faces external adversities (high food and energy prices, drops in export demand or declines in worker remittances)?
 - oil revenues do not start to flow as expected?
- Will it help if potential development impacts of existing international support measures to LDCs are maximized to accelerate progress towards development goals?
 - enhanced official development assistance (ODA)
 - preferential access to foreign markets
- Other (see slide 6: policy simulations/notes)

- 9. Workshop 4 (seminar?): presentation/discussion of policy notes, follow-up steps, uses to support policy formulation and dialogue.
- 10. Policy dialogue; (more) presentations that provide inputs for policy formulation and dialogue, and identification of new demands for policy simulations.
