Appointment of a new member to the Committee for Development Policy

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In view of the passing of a member of the Committee for Development Policy, Eul Yong Park of the Republic of Korea, and in accordance with Economic and Social Council resolutions 1998/46 and 1998/47, the Secretary-General has the honour to nominate Iskra Beleva of Bulgaria to complete the unexpired portion of Mr. Park's term. The proposed appointment would contribute to a more balanced geographical and gender representation in the Committee, as called for in annex I to Economic and Social Council resolution 1998/46.
