DECISIONS

1993/336. Assistance to Guatemala in the field of human rights

At its 47th plenary meeting on 21 October 1993, the Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1993/88 of 10 March 1993, $\underline{1}$ / approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to extend the mandate of the independent expert so that he might continue to examine the situation of human rights in Guatemala and provide assistance to the Government of that country in the field of human rights and submit to the Commission at its fiftieth session a report assessing the measures taken by the Government in accordance with the recommendations made to it.

1993/337. United Nations common system

At its 48th plenary meeting, on 8 December 1993, the Council decided:

- (a) To take note of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled "Relationship agreements between the United Nations and the specialized agencies: review and strengthening of sections pertaining to the common system of salaries, allowances and conditions of service" $\underline{2}/$ and the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the comments of the Administrative Committee on Coordination on that report, $\underline{3}/$ and to transmit the two documents to the General Assembly at its forty-eighth session for further consideration;
- (b) To take note of the note by the Secretary-General on the relationship agreements between the United Nations and member organizations of the United Nations common system $\underline{4}/$ and the note by the Secretariat containing extracts from the reports of the International Civil Service Commission for the year 1991 and the year 1992 concerning the implementation of General Assembly resolutions 45/268 of 29 July 1991 and 46/191 B of 31 July 1992 on the United Nations common system. $\underline{5}/$

1993/338. <u>Dates of the twenty-ninth session of the Committee for Development Planning</u>
