Andrew J. Tatem is a Professor of spatial demography and epidemiology in the department of geography and environment at the University of Southampton. He is also director of the WorldPop project www.worldpop.org and Flowminder Foundation www.flowminder.org, focused on supporting low and middle income countries in improving their demographic evidence bases, responding to humanitarian crises and supporting disease control strategy design.

He works on utilizing multiple types of novel data sets, such as satellite imagery and mobile phone data to compliment traditional data sources in producing detailed maps of population distributions, demographics and dynamics. Through WorldPop and Flowminder he leads partnerships with UN-OCHA, UNFPA, the World Food Program, World Bank and multiple disease control programs and mobile phone network operators around the world.
