




#### Number of international migrants, 2005




### Change in the number of international migrants, 1990-2005



### Countries and territories with the highest proportion of immigrants, 2005




### Female migrants as percentage of total migrants, 2005



#### Female migrants as percentage of total migrants, 2005




### Number of Asians immigrating to selected countries, 1980-2003

### **Share of Asian immigrants in total inflow in selected countries, 1980-2003**





## Number of people from the Pacific immigrating to selected countries, 1980-2003





### Share of migrant workers from ... in selected countries of employment





### Annual net migration per decade by major area,1950-2010





#### Annual net migration per decade in Asia,1950-2050



#### Annual net migration per decade in the Pacific, 1950-2050




## Rates of population change, natural increase and net migration by major area, 1990-2000




■ Rate of change ■ Rate of natural increase ■ Rate of net migration

## Rates of population change, natural increase and net migration by major area, 2040-2050




#### Government policies on immigration, 1976, 1986, 1996 and 2007 – World
