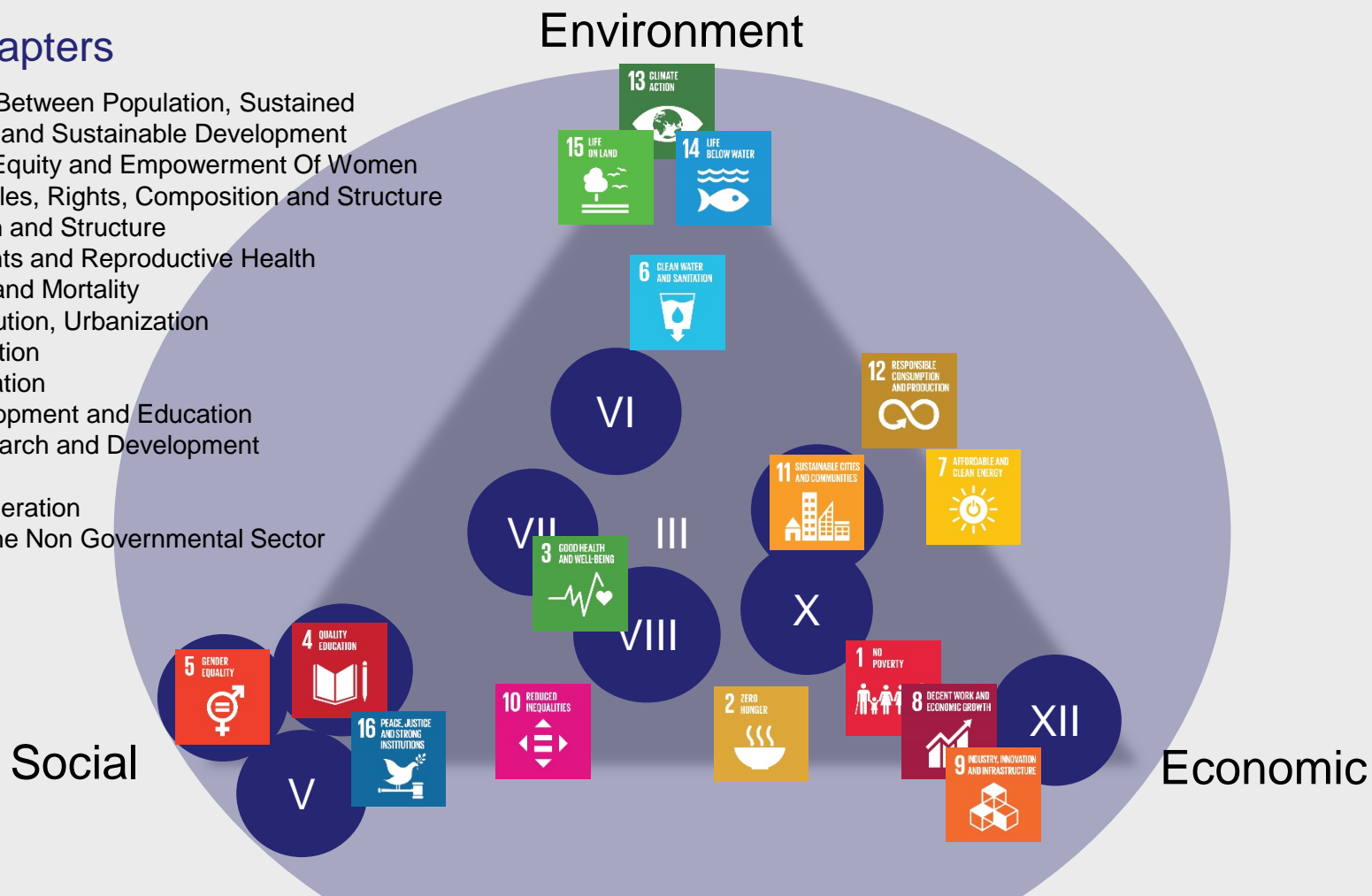

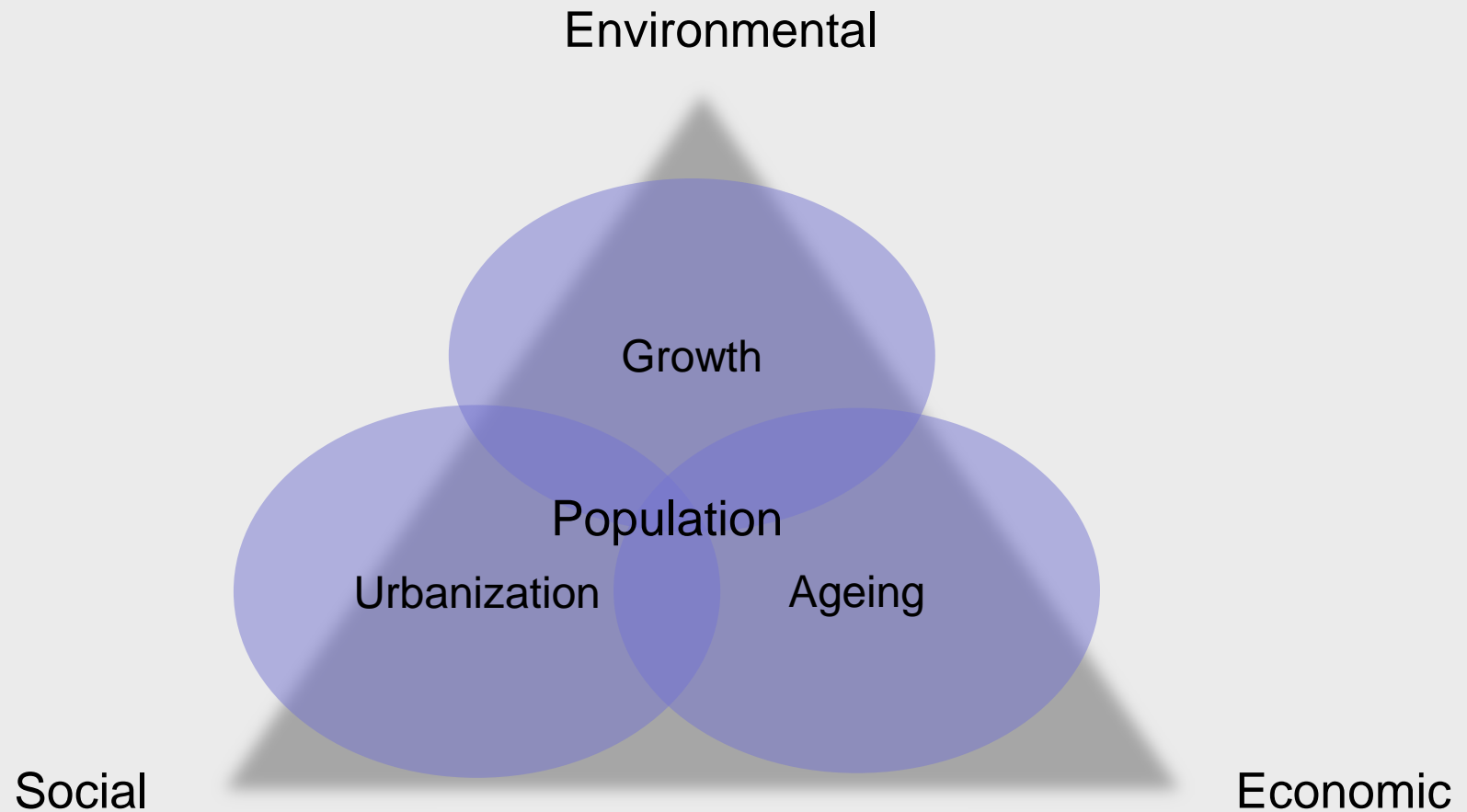

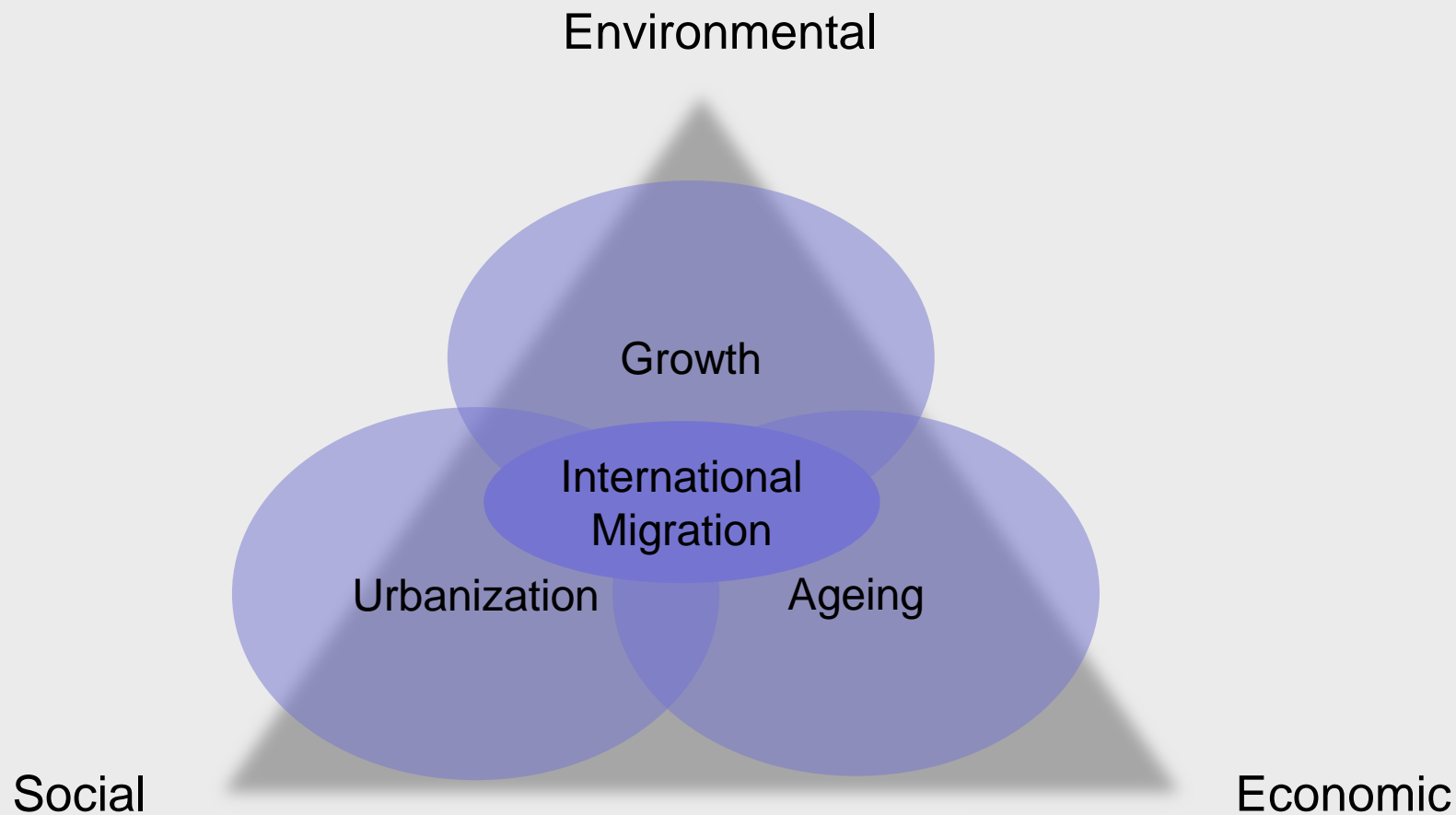

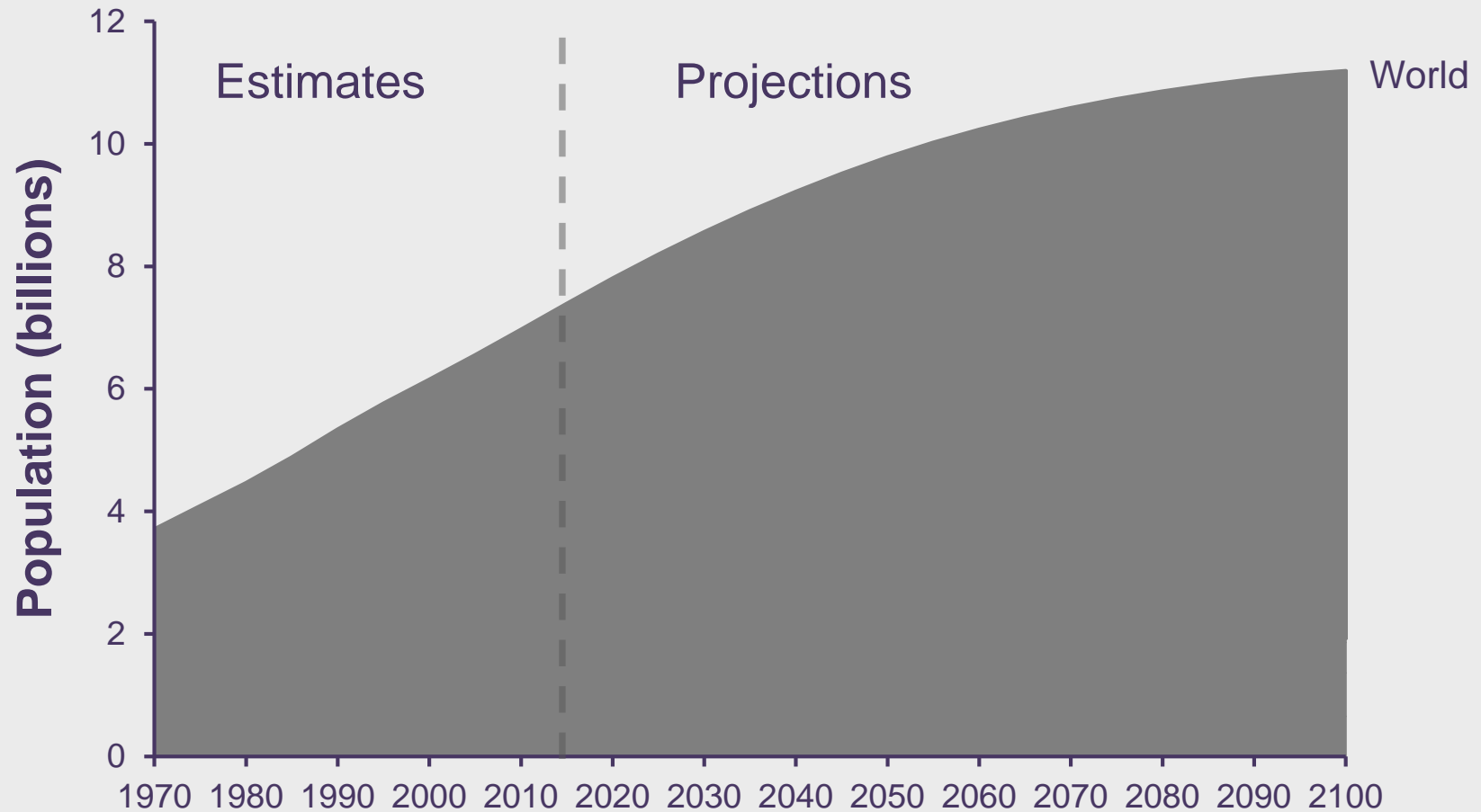

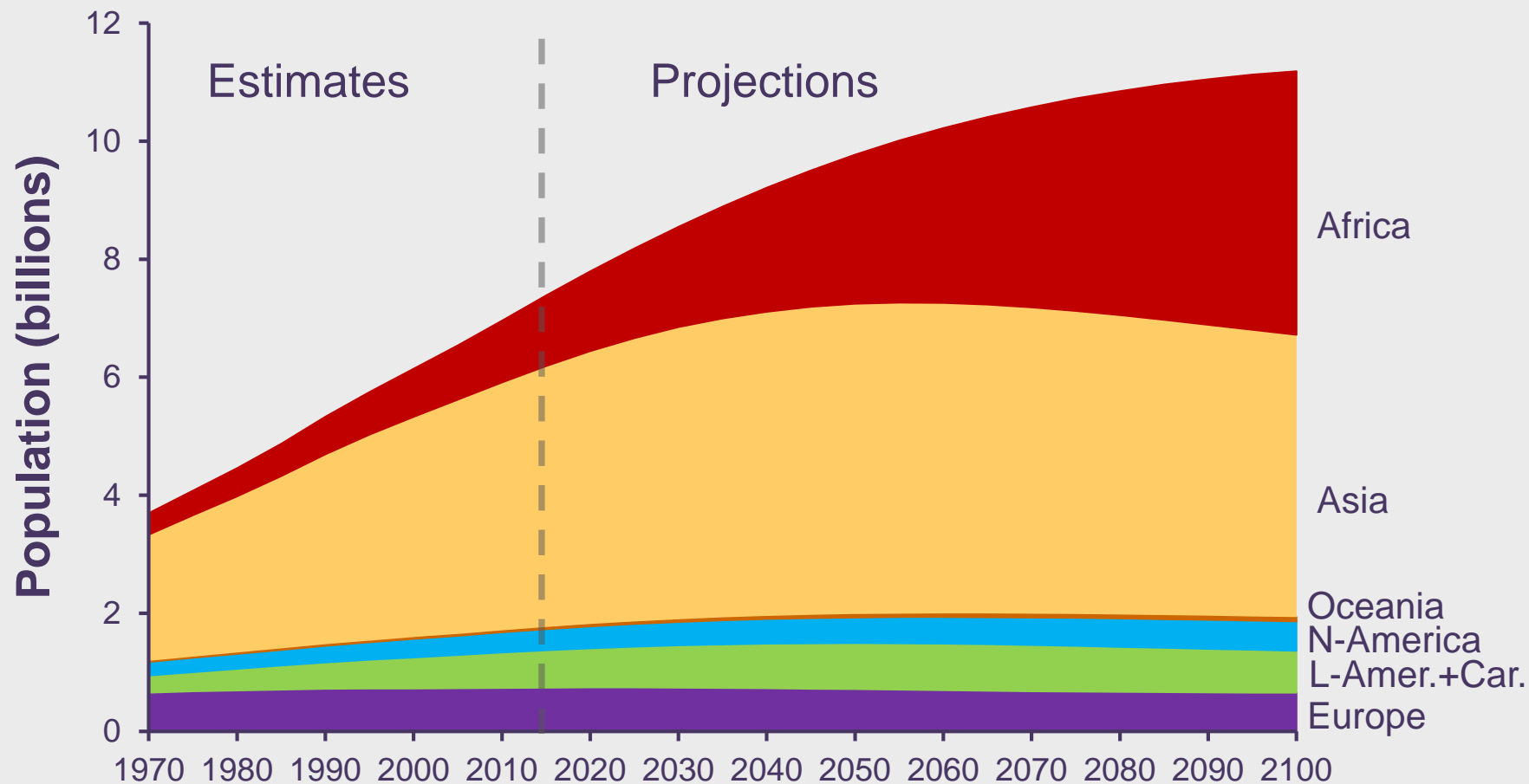

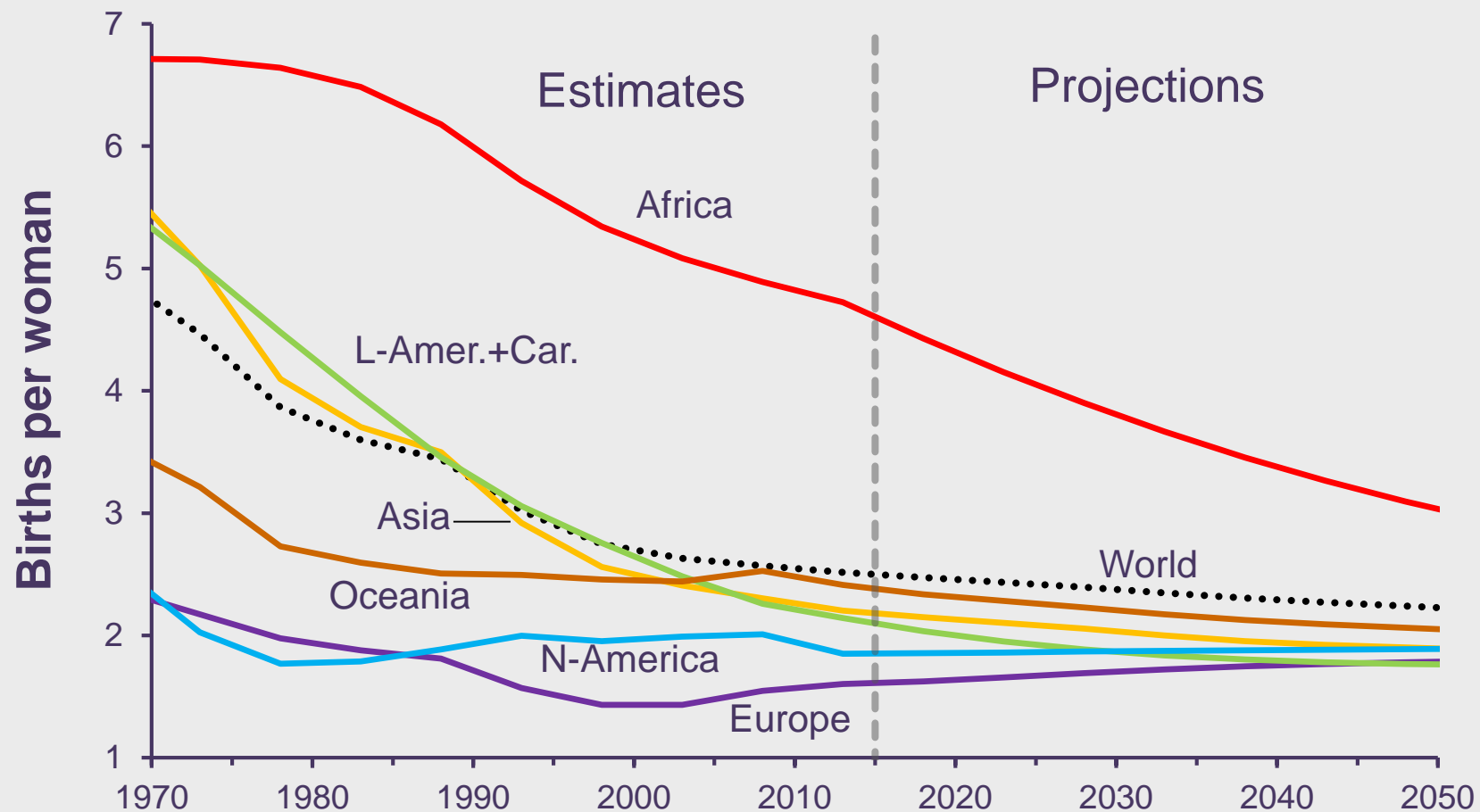

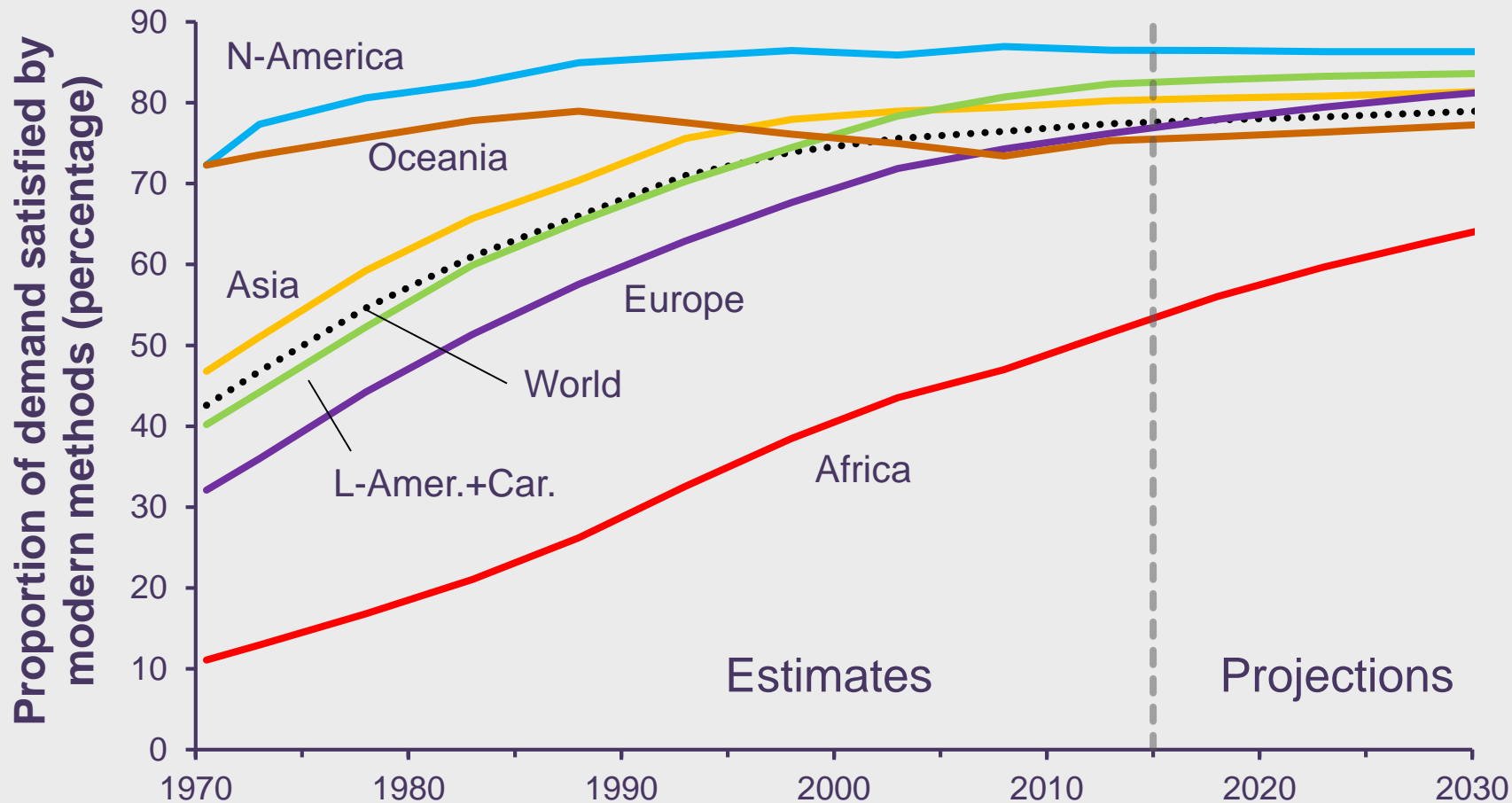

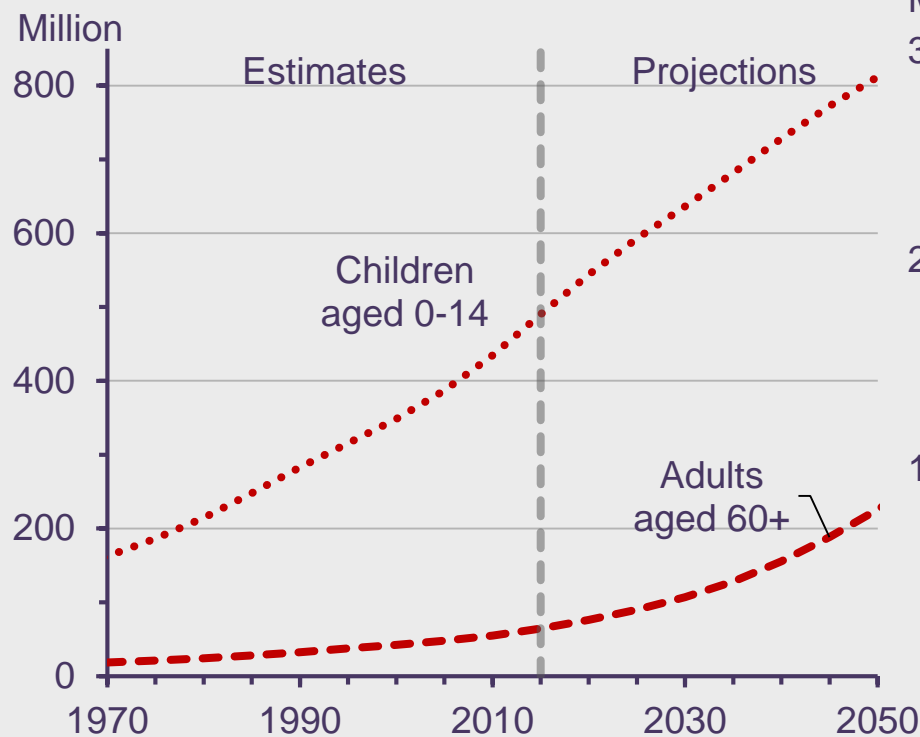

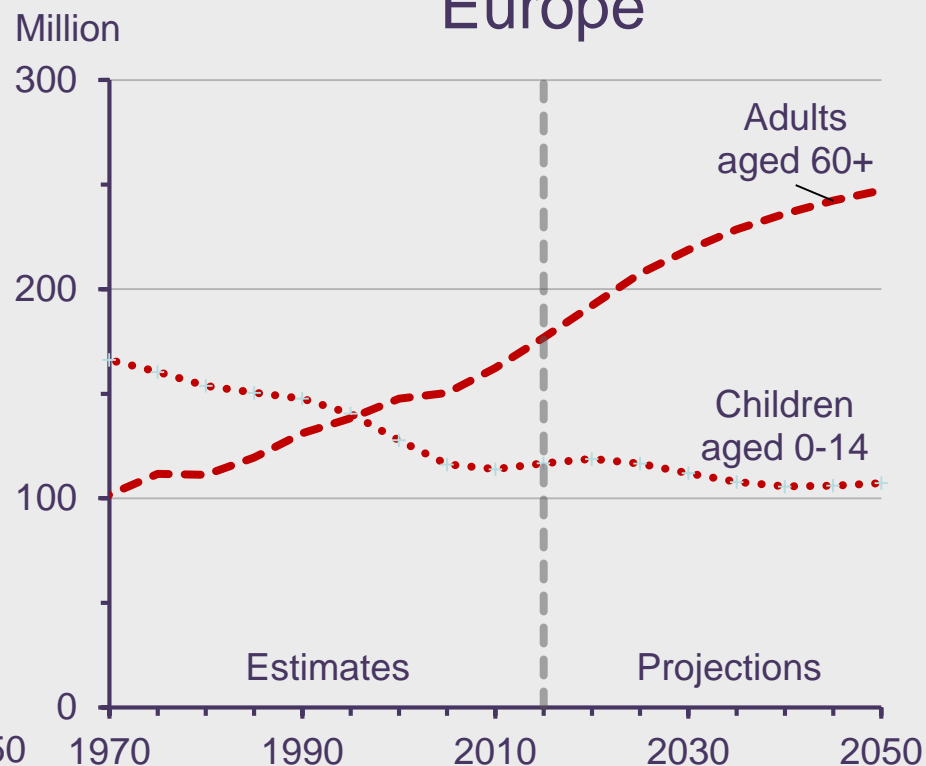


Children and older persons in Africa and Europe

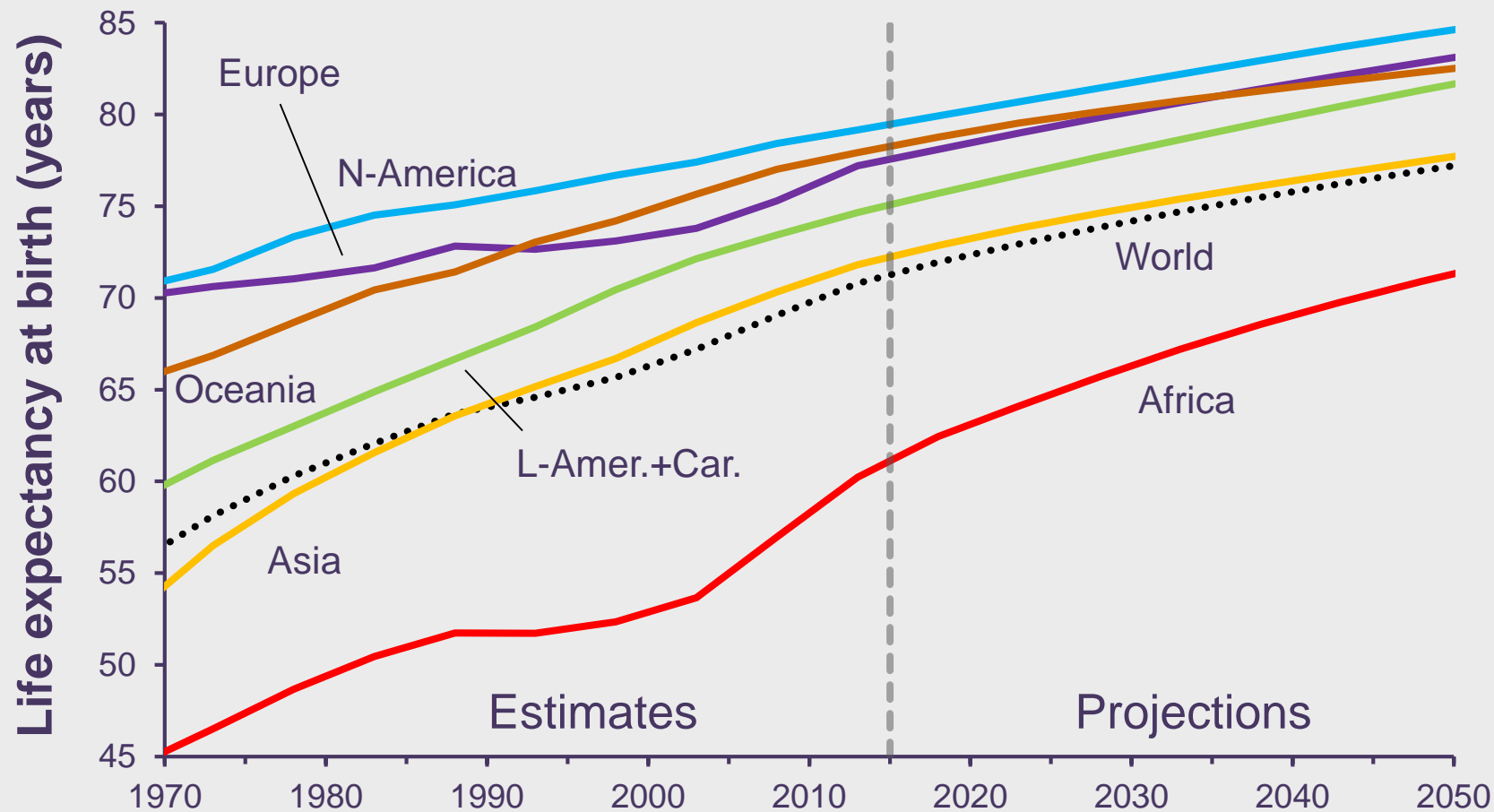

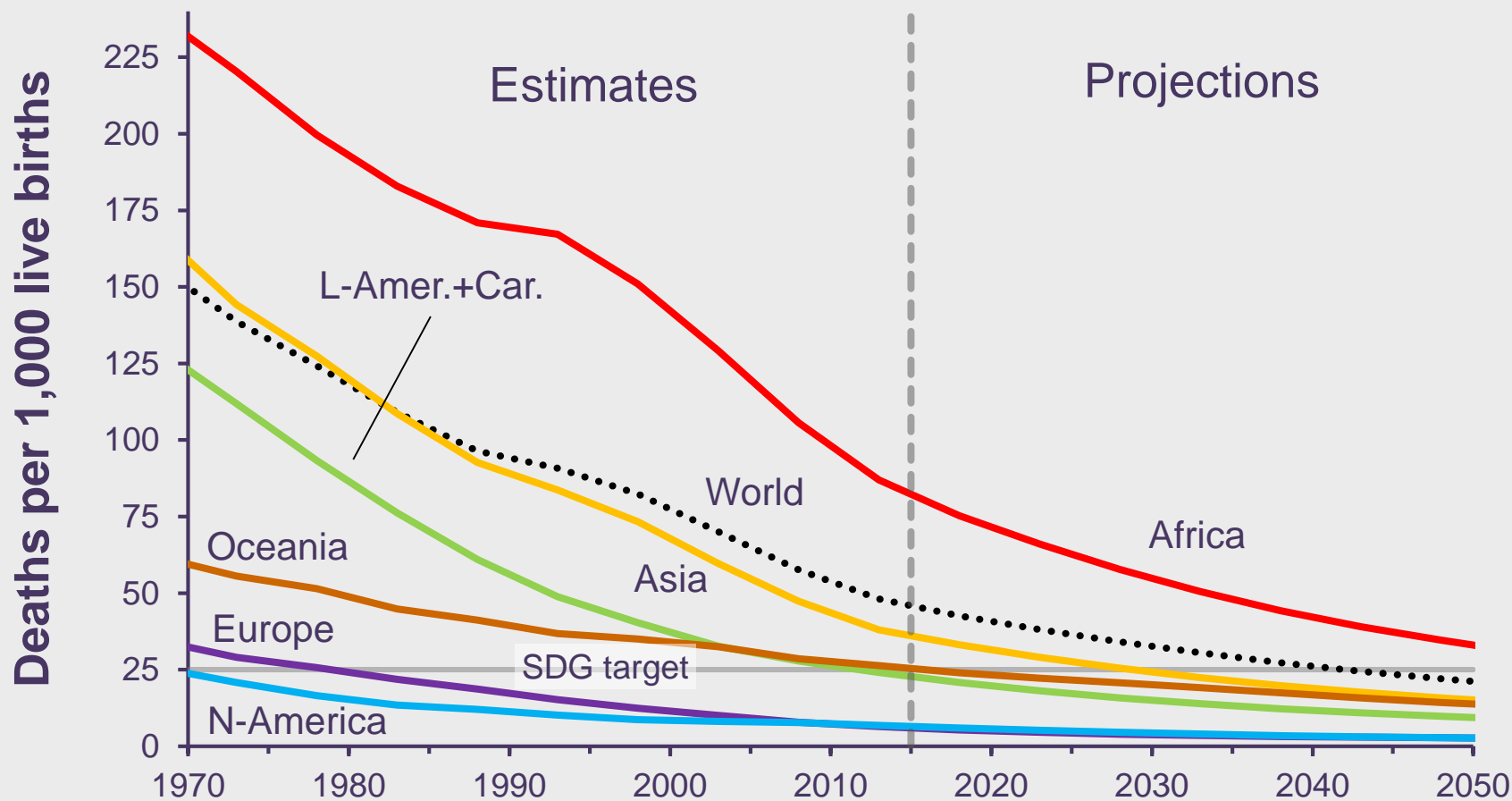

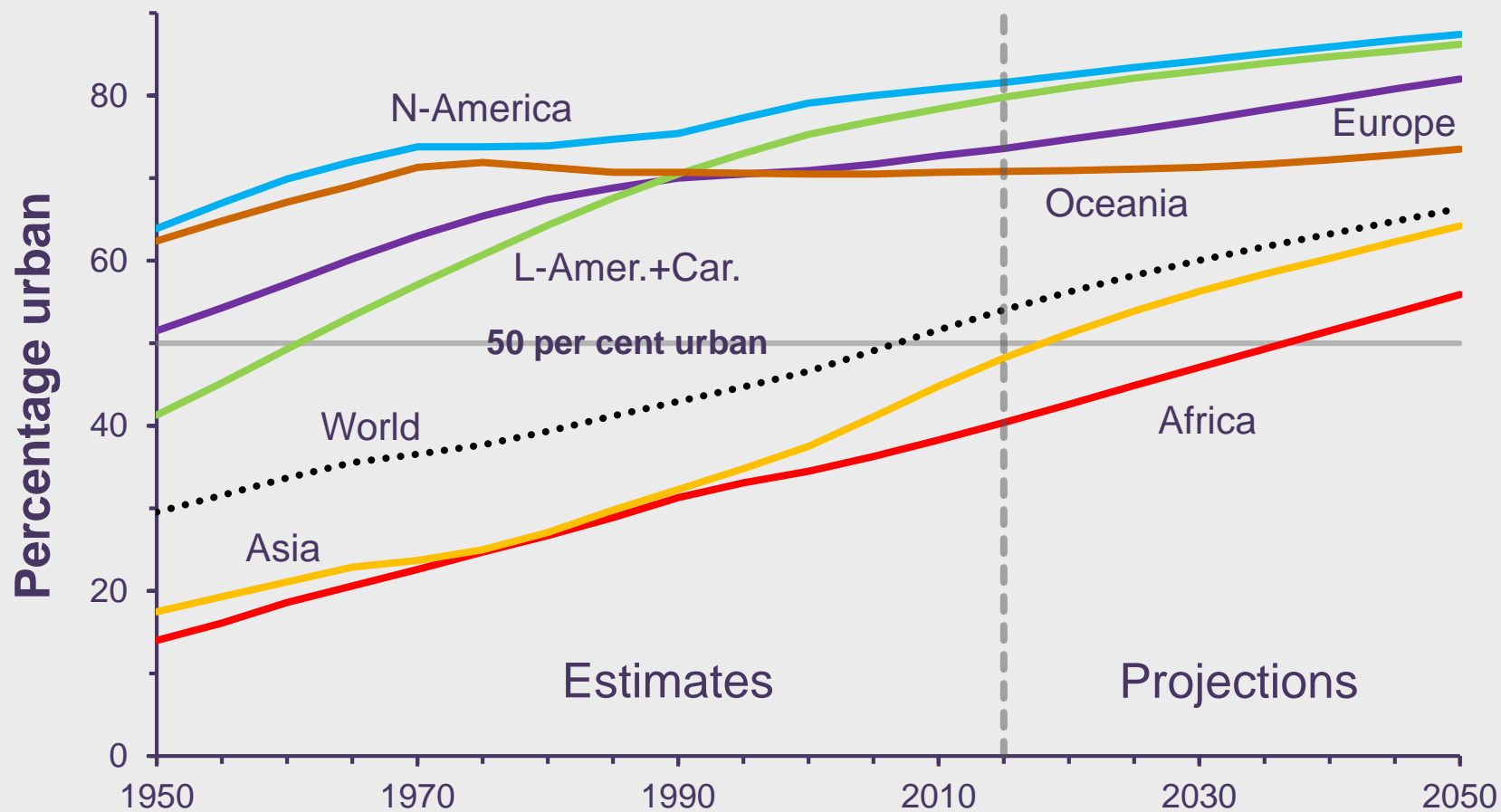

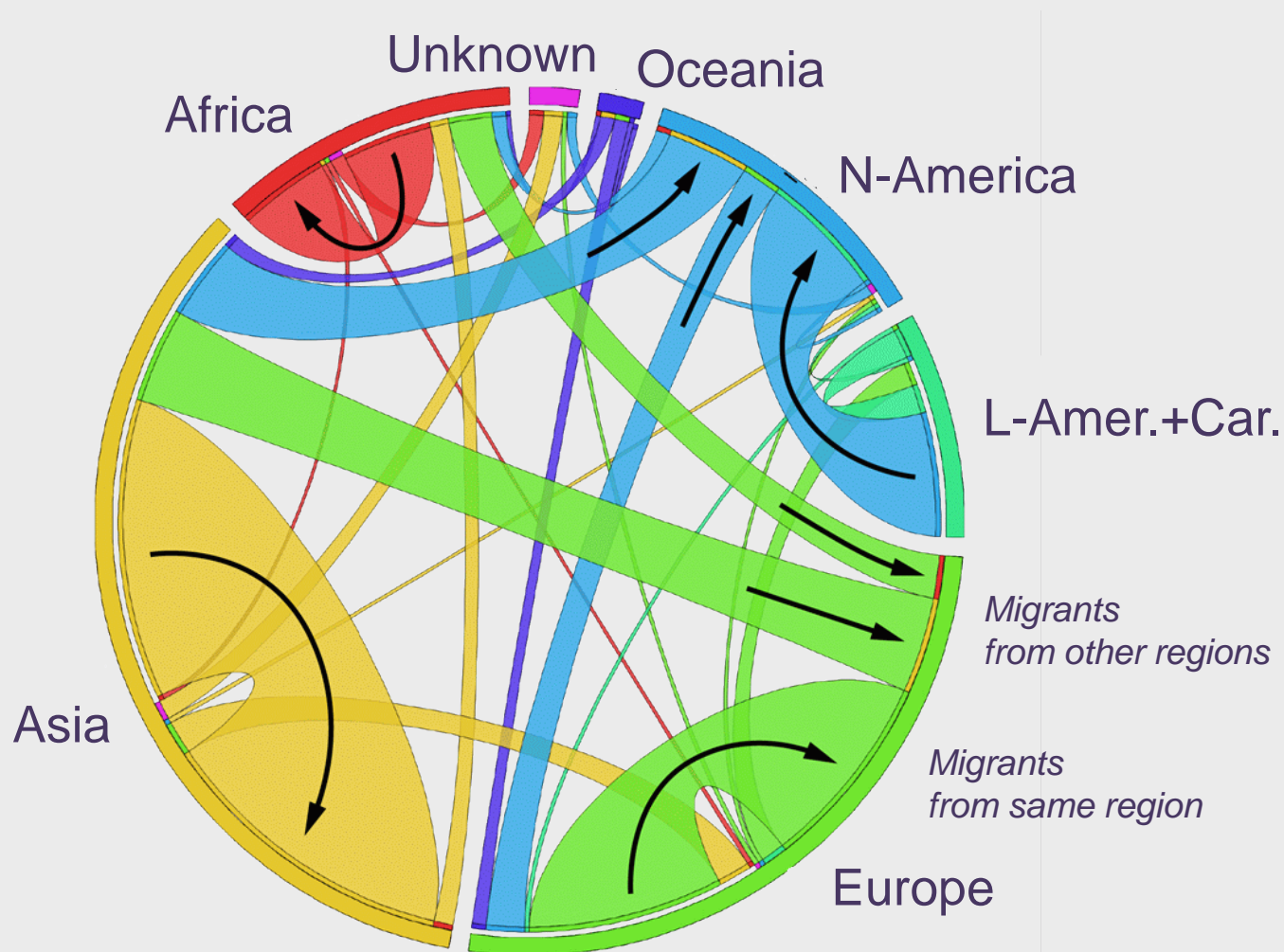
