 Provide policy-makers, the civil society, media and the public at large with reliable and harmonized data migration




 Training and capacity reinforcement of multi-disciplinary South specialists and experts



#### **Planned Trainings**

2011: Data Collection

- Dakar, April 2011: International migration data collection, thematic on diasporas and South-South remittances and statistical software (Inter-regional training)
- → Port au Prince, June 2011: Labour Migration, cross border migration, irregular migration, gender and rights (inter-regional training)



- → Dili, July 2011: Environmental migration and displacement, internal migration (urbanization), migration and health (inter-regional training)
- → National training workshops on data collection on nationally-defined priorities.
