In many countries, **population ageing** is occurring at the same time as many other, equally consequential social and economic transformations. There is increased international recognition of the positive aspects of population ageing, as well as widespread concern that demographic pressures combined with other social and economic changes will affect long-standing societal and familial arrangements that have traditionally been a vital part of the economic support of older people. However, in many countries, how these transformations are affecting the well-being of older persons is uncertain.
