

## **ECOSOC Decision 2004/214**

### **Bureau of the Commission on Sustainable Development**

At its 5th plenary meeting, on 13 February 2004, the Economic and Social Council:

Took note of decision 11/2 adopted by the Commission on Sustainable Development at its eleventh session,<sup>1</sup>

Recalling its resolution 2003/61 of 25 July 2003, entitled “Future programme, organization and methods of work of the Commission on Sustainable Development”, which, inter alia, resulted in the adoption by the Commission of a multi-year programme of work, comprising implementation cycles (review year and policy year),

(a) Noted that the current term of the Bureau of the Commission on Sustainable Development is one year,

(b) Decided to give further consideration to the term of the Bureau of the Commission for future sessions after the completion of the first two-year implementation cycle,<sup>2</sup> in 2005, during its substantive session.
