Indonesia as Middle Income Country


Indonesia increasingly plays a more active role in the global economy and development cooperation


Framework of Indonesia Development Cooperation





- UNDP and Indonesia signed a Partnership Framework Agreement (PFA) on 28 September 2012
- Two of the four objectives in the PFA aim at the strengthening of roles and involvement of Indonesia in international development cooperation in supporting other developing and least developed countries
- Since 2009, Indonesia has cooperated with UNDP to strengthen capacity, ownership, harmonization, accountability and transparency of its development programme within Indonesia's new role as LMIC
- In 2014 alone, UNDP has facilitated five South-South and Triangular Cooperation initiatives between Indonesia and four South countries, i.e. Myanmar (2), Uzbekistan, Vietnam and Morocco
