"Development cooperation in a post-2015 era: sustainable development for all" 23 October 2013, Montreux

On the 24th and 25th of October the Development Cooperation Forum High-Level Symposium "Development cooperation in a post-2015 era: sustainable development for all" will take place in Montreux. The Swiss agency for development and Cooperation (SDC) would like to take the opportunity of this international symposium, jointly organized by the Division Global Institutions and the United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UNDESA), to convene also the principal Swiss stakeholders in the field of development cooperation for a special Swiss side event.

Focus and objectives of the Swiss Side Event

Swiss stakeholders are fundamental players in Switzerland's development cooperation activities. They possess valuable knowledge, based on years of practice-related work in private or public institutions and/or have been involved in political decisions in relation to international cooperation. The future post-2015 agenda will require a new definition of the role of all actors involved in achieving sustainable development for all. By bringing to the national level the discussions that are currently taking place in a multilateral setting the Swiss side event provides an opportunity for Swiss stakeholders to contribute with key messages to the definition of these roles through the DCF/SDC Symposium. The Swiss event on the 23rd of October will give Swiss stakeholders the opportunity to:

- Be informed on the theme and the content of the High Level Symposium.
- Engage in a discussion on the theme of the Symposium and present their own views on the challenges and opportunities ahead.
- Identify Swiss key messages for the Symposium.
