The United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) Youth Forum will take place on 4 May 2012, from 9.30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., in the *ECOSOC Chamber NLB* at the United Nations Headquarters in New York City.

Registration and issuance of identification badges

All participants are asked to register in advance with the ECOSOC Secretariat and pick up their badges in the lobby of the visitors' entrance of the General Assembly (GA) Building, after passing through UN security.

Registration tables will be located in the GA Lobby. Registration will take place from 8.30 am – 10.00 am.

Due to strict security measures, we encourage all participants to arrive at least one hour before the start of the Plenary – scheduled at 9.30 a.m. Non-UN pass holders will be requested to go through the security “tent” at the UN visitors' entrance, located on First Avenue off 46th Street, and present a valid photo ID. You will be required to check in suitcases and large carry-all bags. We apologize for this inconvenience but please allow enough time to go through this process.

Only written registrations received on or before 27 April 2012 will be taken into account for the issuance of an entry badge. Badges have to be worn at all times while in the United Nations premises.

Please note that participation at this event is by invitation only. These invitations can only be transferred with the permission of the meeting organizers.
