Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to General Assembly Resolution 65/1, paragraph 78, which requests the President of the General Assembly at its 68th session to organize a special event in 2013 to follow up on efforts made towards achieving the Millennium Development Goals.

I have the pleasure to forward to you the programme for the Special Event, to be held on Wednesday, 25 September 2013, from 9:00 am to 6:30 pm, in the Trusteeship Council Chamber and CR 2.

The Special Event will deal with the implementation of the MDGs, identify existing gaps to be addressed and pave the way for a transition from MDGs to SDGs. It will be opened in plenary session (9:00 am to 10:30 am), followed by two parallel roundtables in the morning (10:30 am - 1:00 pm) and two parallel roundtables in the afternoon (3:00 pm - 6:00 pm). The subject of the Special Event is also the subject of each of the four roundtables.

The programme has been established drawing on consultations with regional groups, requests made by individual Member States, while aiming to take into consideration the level of speakers and overall geographical balance throughout the high-level week meetings.

I would like to use this opportunity to emphasize again the importance of this meeting in the context of the overall efforts of the United Nations to advance towards the post-2015 development agenda and express my appreciation and support to the two co-facilitators, the Ambassador of Ireland and the Ambassador of South Africa, for their work on the outcome document.
