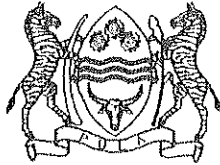
I encourage your delegations to participate actively and constructively in the informal consultations and to extend to H.E. Ambassador Ntwaagae your full cooperation and support.
