| Before 30 April 2014 | The scope and application of the principle of universal jurisdiction | 68/117 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/59) | States and relevant observers are requested to submit information and observations which they might deem relevant for the inclusion in the report of the Secretary-General on the scope and application of universal jurisdiction. |
| 31 May 2016 (Seventy-first session) | Consideration of prevention of transboundary harm from hazardous activities and allocation of loss in the case of such harm | 68/114 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/18) | <p>(a) States are invited to submit further comments on any future action, in particular on the form of respective articles and principles, bearing in mind the recommendations made by the Commission in that regard, including in relation to the elaboration of a convention on the basis of the draft articles, as well as on any practice in relation to the application of the articles and principles.</p> <p>(b) The Secretary-General is requested to submit a compilation of decisions of international courts, tribunals and other bodies referring to the articles and the principles.</p> |

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| 30 May 2014 | Measures to Eliminate International Terrorism | 68/119 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/11) | States are requested to submit data on the status and implementation of existing multilateral, regional and bilateral agreements relating to international terrorism, including information on incidents caused by international terrorism and criminal prosecutions and sentencing, based on information received from the depositaries of those agreements and from Member States. |
| 1 June 2016 | Diplomatic protection | 68/113 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/38) | Governments are requested to submit in writing to the Secretary-General any further comments, including comments concerning the recommendation by the Commission to elaborate a convention on the basis of the articles on diplomatic protection. |
| 30 May 2014 | Criminal accountability of United Nations officials and experts on mission | 68/105 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/50) | All States are requested to submit to the Secretary-General any information on the establishment of jurisdiction for crimes of a serious nature committed by United Nations officials and experts on mission, as well as any practical problems in the implementation of the resolution. |

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| 15 May 2014 | Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives | 67/94 of 14 December 2012 (LA/COD/4) | <p>All States are requested to report to the Secretary-General, in a concise and expeditious manner and in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the Secretary-General, serious violations of the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives as well as missions and representatives with diplomatic status to international intergovernmental organizations;</p> <p>The State in which the violation took place — and, to the extent possible, the State where the alleged offender is present — to report to the Secretary-General, in a concise and expeditious manner and in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the Secretary-General, on measures taken to bring the offender to justice and eventually to communicate, in accordance with its laws, the final outcome of the proceedings against the offender, and to report on measures adopted with a view to preventing a repetition of such violations;</p> <p>States- to inform the Secretary-General of their views with respect to any measures</p> |

| 1 June 2014 | Status of the Protocols Additional to the Geneva Conventions of 1949 and relating to the protection of victims of armed conflicts | 67/94 of 14 December 2012 (LA/COD/2) | Member States are requested to send information which they might deem relevant for inclusion in the report of the Secretary-General on the status of the Additional Protocols relating to the protection of victims of armed conflicts, as well as on measures taken to strengthen the existing body of international humanitarian law, inter alia, with respect to its dissemination and full implementation at the national level. They are encouraged, in transmitting information to the Secretary-General, to focus on new developments and activities during the reporting period. |
| 1 January 2014 | Expulsion of aliens | 67/92 of 14 December 2012 (AL/COD/48) | Governments are invited to submit their comments and observations on the draft articles and commentaries on the topic "Expulsion of aliens" adopted on the first reading by the International Law |

| 31 January 2014 | Formation and evidence of customary international law/ Identification of customary international law | 68/112 of 16 December 2013 (LA/COD/62) | <p>The General Assembly drew the attention of Governments to the importance of having their views on the various aspects of the topic “Formation and evidence of customary international law”, in particular on all the specific issues identified in chapter III of its report. In the report on its sixty-fifth session (A/68/10), the Commission requested States to provide information on their practice relating to the formation of customary international law and the type of evidence suitable for establishing such law in a given situation, as set out in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Official statements before legislatures, courts and international organizations; and (b) Decisions of national, regional and subregional courts. |
