15 May 2012	Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives	65/30 of 6 December 2010 (LA/COD/4)	All States to report to the Secretary-General, in a concise and expeditious manner and in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the Secretary-General, serious violations of the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives as well as missions and representatives with diplomatic status to international intergovernmental organizations.
31 May 2012	Measures to Eliminate International Terrorism	66/105 of 9 December 2011 (LA/COD/11/1)	Member States to submit data on the status and implementation of existing multilateral, regional and bilateral agreements relating to international terrorism, including information on incidents caused by international terrorism and criminal prosecutions and sentencing, based on information received from the depositaries of those agreements and from Member States.
1 June 2012	Status of the Protocols Additional to the Geneva Conventions of 1949 and relating to the protection of victims of armed conflicts	65/29 of 6 December 2010 (LA/COD/2)	Member States are requested to send information which they might deem relevant for inclusion in the report of the Secretary-General on the status of the Additional Protocols relating to the protection of victims of armed conflicts, as well as on measures taken to strengthen the existing body of international humanitarian law, inter alia, with respect to its dissemination and full implementation at the national level.
