on an exist	ing GA resolution, the official Word version of that GA resolution
(downloaded	from ODS – the Official Documents System as document
"A/RES//_	") should be used as the base text. The new text and changes
<u>should be</u> c	learly marked using track changes ¹ , in the electronic and hardcopy
versions of t	he submitted text.

Similarly, (A/C.3/72/L in the elect document. processing o	when submitting revisions to an already issued draft resolution document), the changes should be clearly marked using track changes ronic and hardcopy versions of the already issued "A/C.3/72/L' Drafts not in compliance with above guidelines will delay the of the draft resolution.
3. The hard	copy version of the draft proposal, <u>duly signed by the Main Sponsor/s</u>
must include	the following information at the top of the submitted draft proposals
name, phone,	<i>cell and e-mail of the Facilitator</i> .
4. The <u>list o</u>	f Co-sponsors will be generated by the eSponsorship platform.
5. The Secre	tariat requires <u>at least 48 hours</u> to process and issue a draft resolution,
and, if requ	ired, a statement of Programme Budget Implications (PBIs) of the
activities to	be adopted in the draft resolution. More time is required whenever the
draft resolut	ion will give rise to programme budget implications and a separate L
document w	ith PBIs needs to be issued.

¹ HOW TO TRACK CHANGES IN WORD

Locate the officially issued resolution on the ODS (A/RES/71/__.--) and "Save As" the document as a new document in Word;

On the tools menu, choose the "Track Changes" option to open the Reviewing toolbar;

Turn on Track Changes option by clicking the icon and makes changes onto the document; Any changes to the original text will now be indicated in the document.
