Order of the President

The Judges of the United Nations Appeals Tribunal (Appeals Tribunal) met in plenary on 5 March 2012 and pursuant to Article 32(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the Appeals Tribunal (Rules), decided to amend Articles 7(1), 9(3), and (9)(4) of the Rules to read as follows:

Article 7(1)

Appeals instituting proceedings shall be submitted to the Appeals Tribunal through the Registrar within:

(a) **45 60** calendar days of the receipt by a party appealing a judgment of the Dispute Tribunal;

Article 9(3)

The signed original answer form and the annexes thereto shall be submitted together to the Registrar within **45 60** days of the date on which the respondent received the appeal transmitted by the Registrar. The documents may be transmitted electronically.

Article 9(4)

Within **45 60** days of notice of the appeal, a party answering the appeal may serve a notice of cross-appeal with the Appeals Tribunal stating the relief sought and the grounds of the cross-appeal. The cross-appeal may not add new claims.

In accordance with Article 32(2) of the Rules, the amendments shall operate provisionally until approved by the General Assembly.
