Introduction

1. On 8 July 2021, the Applicant, an Administrative Assistant, at the FS-4 level, working with the United Nations-African Union Hybrid Operation in Darfur (“UNAMID”) filed an application contesting UNAMID’s decision to terminate her continuing appointment without any attempt by the Administration to secure her alternative positions.¹
2. On 9 August 2021, the Respondent filed a reply where it was argued that the contested decision is lawful.
3. The Tribunal held a case management discussion on 13 April 2022. During the discussion, the parties declared readiness to informally resolve the dispute.

Deliberation

4. Pursuant to art. 19 of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (“UNDT”) Rules of Procedure, the UNDT may at any time, either on an application of a party or on its own initiative, issue any order or give any direction which appears to a judge to be appropriate for the fair and expeditious disposal of the case and to do justice to the parties.

ORDER

5. On or before 25 April 2022, the parties shall inform the Tribunal as to whether the case has been resolved. If so, the Applicant shall confirm to the Tribunal, in writing, that her application is withdrawn finally and entirely.
