ON CASE MANAGEMENT

Introduction

1. On 24 September 2021, the Applicant appealed the decision to impose on her a disciplinary sanction of separation from service, with compensation *in lieu* of notice, and with termination indemnity. Together with her application, the Applicant filed a motion to be granted anonymity in the case.

2. On 28 October 2021, the Respondent replied that the application is without merit.

3. By Order No. 023 (NY/2022) dated 3 March 2022, the Tribunal ordered, *inter alia*, the parties to file a joint submission containing a consolidated list of agreed and disagreed facts. The Tribunal further ordered that each party file a submission on whether they request a hearing in this case and what additional evidence, if any, is to be produced.

4. The parties duly filed their submissions informing the Tribunal that they did not request a hearing in this matter and that the case could be adjudicated on the papers.

5. In her 28 March 2022 submission, the Applicant requested leave to include in the record further documents and to file a rejoinder.

Consideration

Case management

6. The Applicant requested leave to include in the record two documents. The first is an email exchange with the Medical Services Division in June 2021 and the second an email exchange concerning payments with an outside consultant in 2012. The

Applicant further requests the opportunity to file a further submission in regard to her medical documentation and to submit further clarifications.

7. The Tribunal will grant the Applicant leave to include the additional disclosure in the record and to file further submissions, which are solely to be based on the submissions and evidence already on record. The Respondent may file a response to the Applicant's submission.

8. In light of the above,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

9. The Applicant's request to include two documents in the record is granted;

10. By **4:00 p.m. on Monday, 18 April 2022**, the Applicant is to file her further submission. No new evidence is to be submitted at this stage of the proceedings. The statement is to be three pages maximum, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing;

11. By **4:00 p.m. on Friday, 29 April 2022**, the Respondent may file a response to the Applicant's further submission. No new evidence is to be submitted at this stage of the proceedings. The statement is to be three pages maximum, using Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing.
