Introduction

1. By Order No. 090 (NY/2022) dated 30 September 2022, the Tribunal ordered

the Respondent to file his replies in both cases by 31 October 2022, addressing: (a) the

merits of the two cases, and (b) the issue of joining the two cases under one case

number.

2. On 31 October 2022, the Respondent filed the replies.

Consideration

Joining the two cases

3. In the application of *Kutner* et al., the Applicant requested that the two cases be

joined "[i]n light of the identical pleadings". In line herewith, when adjudicating on the

Dispute Tribunal's findings of non-receivability, the Appeals Tribunal joined the two

cases before the Dispute Tribunal under the same Case No. 2021-1605 and only issued

one and the same judgment in Ovcharenko et al. Kutner et al. 2022-UNAT-1262.

4. Despite the Tribunal's explicit order for the Respondent to file his submissions

on this matter in his replies, he did not do so. The Tribunal regards this omission as the

Respondent, at minimum, agreeing to the two cases being handled together, also noting

that the two cases indeed concern the same issue(s).

5. Accordingly, for efficiency purpose and to do justice to the parties, Case Nos.

UNDT/NY/2021/021/R1 and UNDT/NY/2021/024/R1 are to be handled together.

This means that whereas the two case numbers will remain with each of the cases, the

Tribunal will adjudicate the issue(s) before it in only one judgment.

Further case management

6. The Tribunal notes that the cases are fully briefed, and the parties do not request

any further evidence to be produced. The case may therefore be determined on the basis

of the documents on record.

7. However, the Tribunal deems it appropriate to afford the Applicant an

opportunity to respond to the Respondent's replies.

8. In light thereof,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

9. Case Nos. UNDT/NY/2021/021/R1 and UNDT/NY/2021/024/R1 are handled

together and only one judgment is to be issued;

10. By **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 29 November 2022**, the Applicants may submit a

response to the Respondent's reply. The submission shall not exceed five pages, using

Times New Roman, font 12 and 1.5 line spacing.

11. Upon receipt of the Applicants' submissions, unless instructed otherwise, the

Tribunal will proceed to adjudicate this matter on the papers before it.
