Bujumbura, Burundi – On her last day in office, the Special Representative of the Secretary General in Burundi, Carolyn McAskie, met with the President of Burundi, Pierre Nkurunziza in a farewell visit today in Bujumbura.

Speaking to reporters at the end of her meeting with the President of Burundi, Carolyn McAskie, said: “It was a great honour for me to be received by the President on my last day as Special representative in Burundi. For one last time, we have discussed the main domains of cooperation between the United Nations and Burundi. It was a very moving moment for me. I wanted to congratulate the President once again on the work he is doing now and assured him that the United Nations will continue their support of the consolidation of the peace process.”
