### 19. The situation in Cyprus

During the period under review, the Security Council held eight meetings, including four private/closed meetings with the troop-contributing countries, <sup>1</sup> and adopted four resolutions on the situation in Cyprus. The Council in its deliberations focused on the various political developments in Cyprus, including the relevant role and mandate of the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).<sup>2</sup> In addition, the Council continued to support the good offices mission of the Secretary-General, his efforts to assist the parties in the negotiation process and his appointment of a new Special Adviser of the Secretary-General on Cyprus and force commander of UNFICYP. The Council also welcomed the Joint Declaration adopted by the Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot leaders on 11 February 2014, including the resumption of negotiations, and encouraged both sides to continue to work with UNFICYP to reach a comprehensive settlement.

The Council on four occasions extended the mandate of UNFICYP,<sup>3</sup> with the last extension for the period ending on 31 January 2016, in accordance with the relevant recommendations contained in the reports of the Secretary-General.<sup>4</sup>
