En relación a su nota S/AC.44/2007/OC.47 de 28 de diciembre de 2007, mediante la cual solicita información sobre las medidas que cada Estado hubiera adoptado o previera adoptar para aplicar la resolución 1540 (2004) del Consejo de Seguridad, me es grato remitir adjunto a la presente, la matriz sobre la implementación de la resolución antes mencionada por parte del Gobierno del Ecuador.

Cabe destacar que el Ministerio de Relaciones Exteriores, Comercio e Integración es la autoridad política y los responsables técnicos son el Comando Conjunto de las Fuerzas Armadas y la Policía Nacional, conforme el Código Penal y la Ley de Fabricación, Importación, Exportación, Comercialización y Tenencia de armas, municiones, explosivos y accesorios, en el caso de las armas pequeñas ligeras. En el caso de armas químicas, se encuentra a cargo, la Autoridad Nacional de Armas Químicas, conforme el Decreto Ejecutivo No. 246-A, de 29 de abril de 1997; y la Comisión Ecuatoriana de Energía Atómica, en el caso de las armas nucleares conforme la Ley de la Comisión Ecuatoriana de Energía Atómica.

Por otra parte, el Gobierno del Ecuador no tiene inconveniente alguno en que este informe sea considerado un documento público.
