Information on Indicators for sustainable development

The findings in the Development Report 2007 are mostly based on the results obtained through the set of indicators designed to monitor overall development. The set of indicators largely corresponds to the set applied in 2006, although it has been extended in some areas. Last year the first attempt was made to assess Slovenia's development by means of a mathematical model based on selected indicators. This year, the model was improved by including significantly more indicators and extending the analysed time period. The analysis in the Development Report 2007 is based on the official statistical data of domestic and foreign institutions that were available by the end of January 2007. In the analyses, Slovenia is mostly compared with other countries of the EU-25.
