

Ms. Rosalud Jing de la Rosa is representing WOCAN (Women Organizing for Change in Agriculture and Natural Resource Management) at the CSD. She was WOCAN's founding Chair from 2004 to 2008. Born and raised in Manila, she migrated and spent the past 26 years of her professional life working as consultant with UN agencies, women's NGOs, foundations and academic institutions based in New York, Geneva, Central and West Africa and Rome. She was appointed as the first Reproductive Health Coordinator for the UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) during the 1995 exodus of the 1.2 million Rwandan refugees in the Great Lakes Region.

Ms. de la Rosa has been in the forefront of advocacy initiatives for women's rights related to sustainable development, reproductive health, land, food security and migration and have designed and implemented several global collaborative programs.
