Dates and Venue

The ninth session of the Committee of Experts on International Cooperation in Tax Matters will take place at the Palais des Nations in Geneva, Switzerland from 21-25 October 2013. The meetings will be held in conference room XIX, located on the 3rd floor of the New Building of the Palais (Batiment E), which is accessible through outer doors marked Porte 40 of the Palais.

Note: Please be advised to check our website (http://www.un.org/esa/ffd/tax/ninthsession/) regularly for updates on conference documents. Participants are urged to bring their own copies of documents as the copying facilities available to us in Geneva will be very limited.

Registration

To register, participants are requested to use one of the following options:

In both cases participants should retain a hard copy of their completed registration form and bring it with them when registering with UN Security in Geneva.

To obtain their grounds passes, participants are requested to report to the UN Security at the "New Pregny Building" on 21 October between 9:00 and 9:30 am. Participants are requested to bring with them:

- 1) Copy of their registration form (see above); and
- 2) Photo ID (Passport, National ID or a Driver License).

Travel and Hotel Accommodations

The UN cannot provide travel or accommodation costs to participants, arrange flights, or organize hotel accommodations.

- 3) Selected hotel or budgeted amount per night (with or without breakfast);
- 4) Type of room (single/double/suite); and
- 5) Credit card number with expiration date (to guarantee the reservation).
