- UN Strategic Plan for Forests 2030: regional bodies are crucial bridge between international policies and national actions
- Expert group meeting held in Nairobi in November 2017 to discuss:
 - Contributions of regional and subregional organizations and processes to the implementation of the UNSPF
 - Regional/sub-regional voluntary reporting format and cycle
 - Input to the 2018 HLPF on contributions of forests to SDGs under consideration
 - Promotion of collaboration with regional and subregional processes including invitation from COFO to be considered by the Forum

Major Groups (MGs) & Other Stakeholders contributions to implementation of UN Strategic Plan for Forests 2030

- The Strategic Plan encourages Major Groups (MGs) to establish and maintain a coordination mechanism.
- UNFF12 encouraged Major Groups to:

 - Provide inputs to HLPF 2018
- Expert meeting held in Nairobi in November 2017 (30 Major Groups representatives) to discuss:
 - MG workplan key elements; contributions to GFG attainment; actions required for implementation & potential key partners
 - contributions of forests to HLPF 2018
