**Draft programme of work of the Population Division,
Department of Economic and Social Affairs, for the
period 2006-2007**

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Subprogramme 6, Population, of programme 7, Economic and social affairs, of the biennial programme plan for the period 2006-2007 (A/59/6/Rev.1 (Prog. 7)) falls under the responsibility of the Population Division.

2. The biennial programme plan of this subprogramme for the period 2006-2007 containing the strategy, objective, expected accomplishments and indicators of achievement was adopted by the General Assembly in its resolution 59/275 of 23 December 2004 and forms the basis for the preparation of the programme of work to be included in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007. The plan as adopted by the Assembly reflects the recommendations of the Committee for Programme Coordination subsequent to the submission of the plan to the Commission on Population and Development at its thirty-seventh session in document E/CN.9/2004/6.

3. The draft programme of work of this subprogramme, annexed hereto, has been formulated taking into account the mandates contained in the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development (Cairo, 1994), the outcome of the twenty-first special session of the General Assembly (New York, 1999) at which the Assembly adopted the key actions for the further implementation of the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development, and the outcomes of other relevant international conferences, including the Millennium Summit.

4. The subprogramme will continue to promote increased understanding and awareness of Member States and civil society, including non-governmental organizations, of the issues in the field of population and development, such as international migration, population ageing and the HIV/AIDS pandemic. The subprogramme will also seek to provide to Governments and civil society improved and timely access to the United Nations population estimates and projections as well as other research findings in the field of population and development. The outputs as well as the external factors that would affect the implementation of the draft programme of work of subprogramme 6 are reflected in the annex.

5. The draft programme of work that is before the Commission for its information will be incorporated in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007, to be approved by the General Assembly at its sixtieth session.
