

Decision 44/101
International migration and migrants from a social perspective

The Commission for Social Development,

Recalling General Assembly resolution 60/227 of 23 December 2005 entitled International Migration and Development, in which the General Assembly noted that the Commission on Population and Development, the Commission for Social Development and the Commission on the Status of Women would have considered the issue of international migration within their respective mandates by the time of the High-Level Dialogue, and invited their inputs through the Economic and Social Council;

Also recalling the panel discussion held during the forty-second session of the Commission on “International migration and migrants from a social perspective”;

Decides to transmit, through the Economic and Social Council to the High-Level Dialogue on International Migration and Development, to be held in September 2006 during the sixty-first session of the general Assembly, the Chairman’s summary of the panel discussion on international migration and migrants from a social perspective, held during its forty-second session.¹
