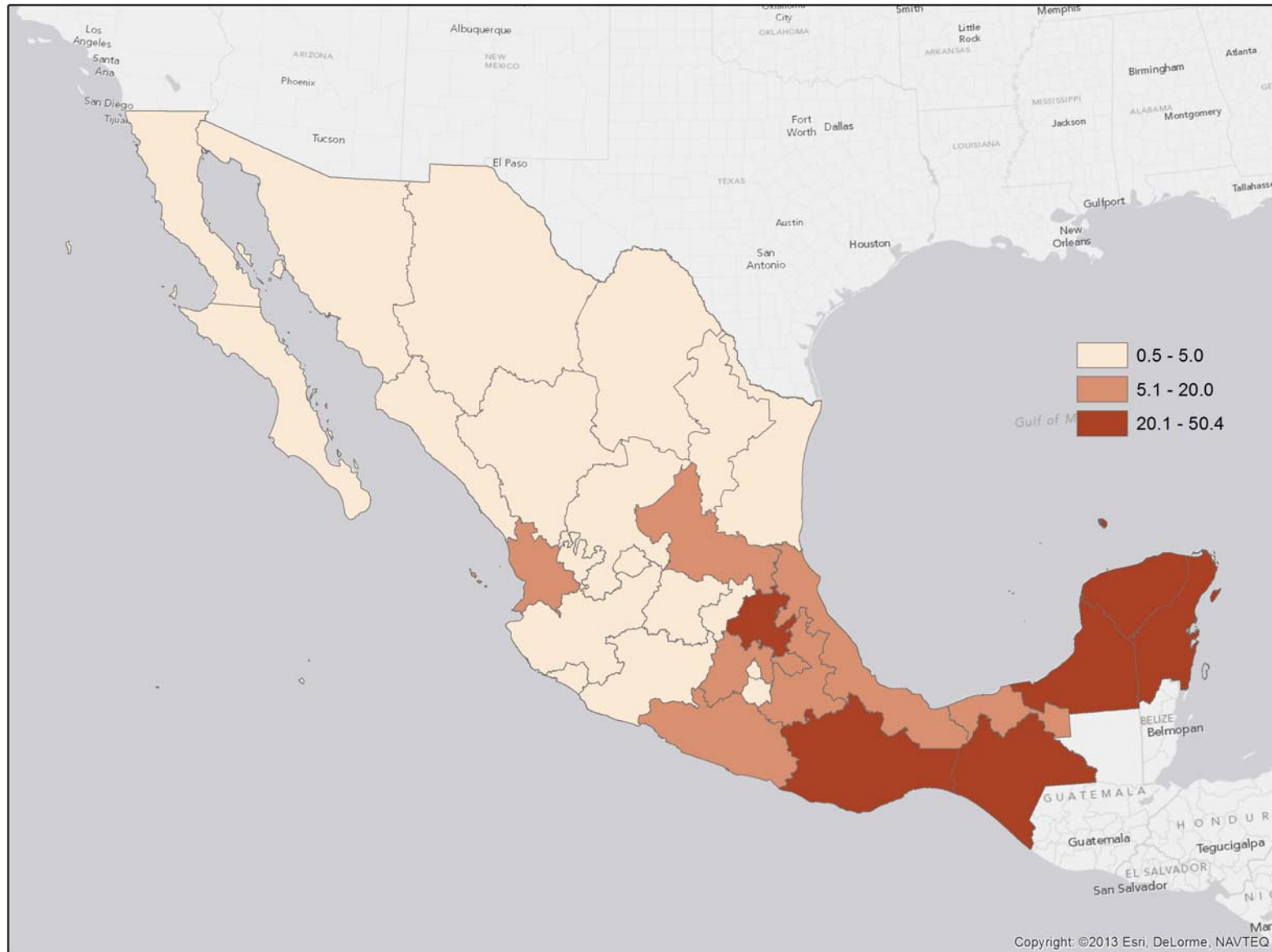

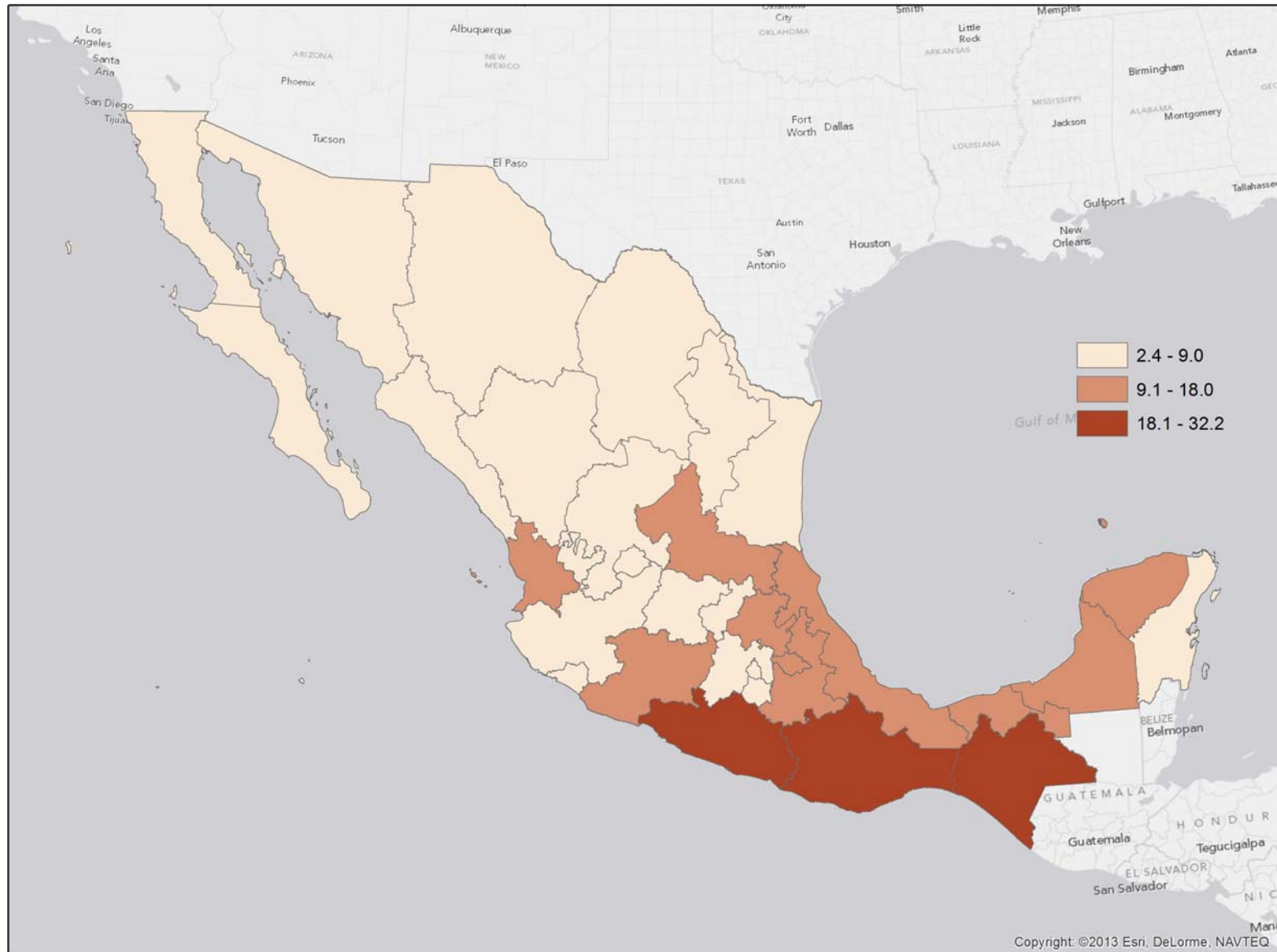

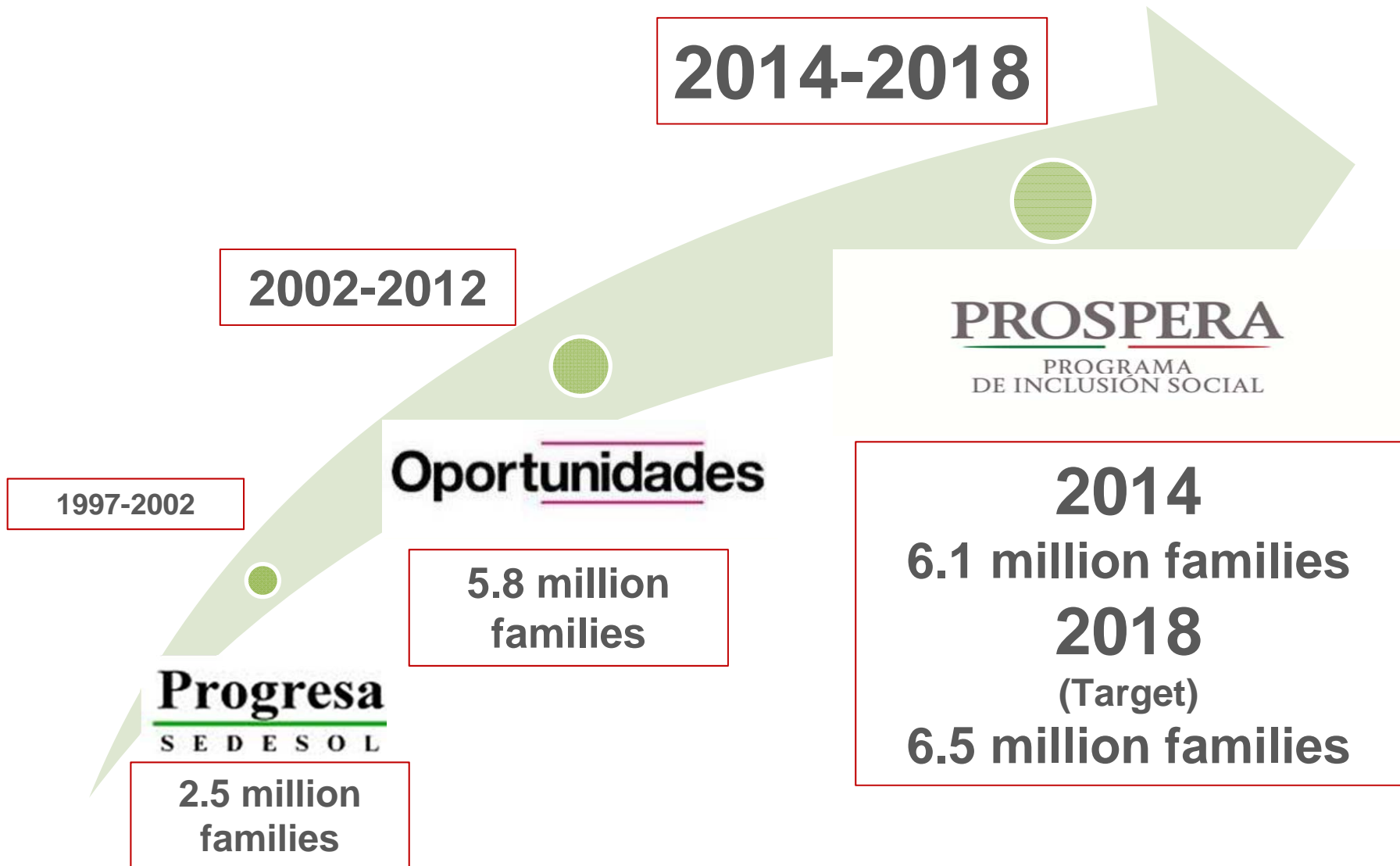
Indigenous population as % of total population. Mexico, 2010



Extreme poverty rate in federal states. Mexico, 2012

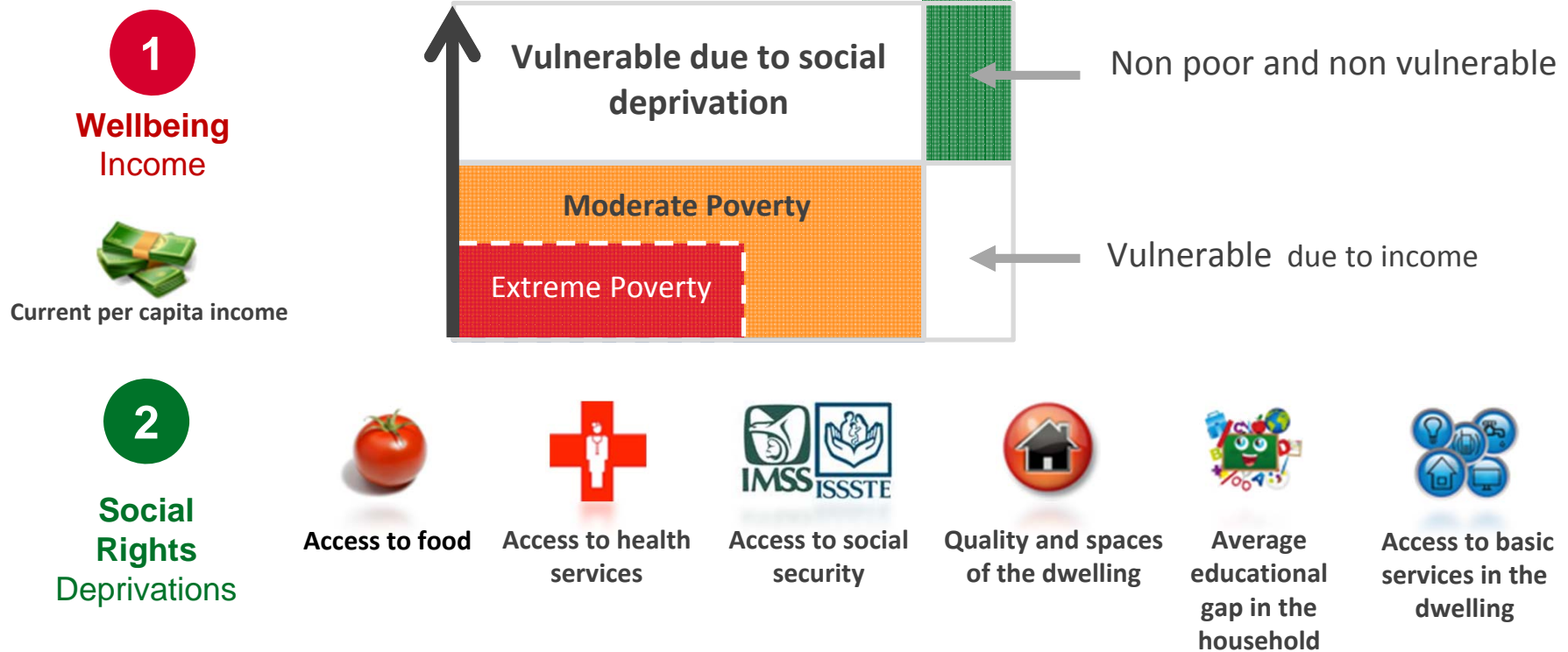


Coverage of The Program *Prospera*



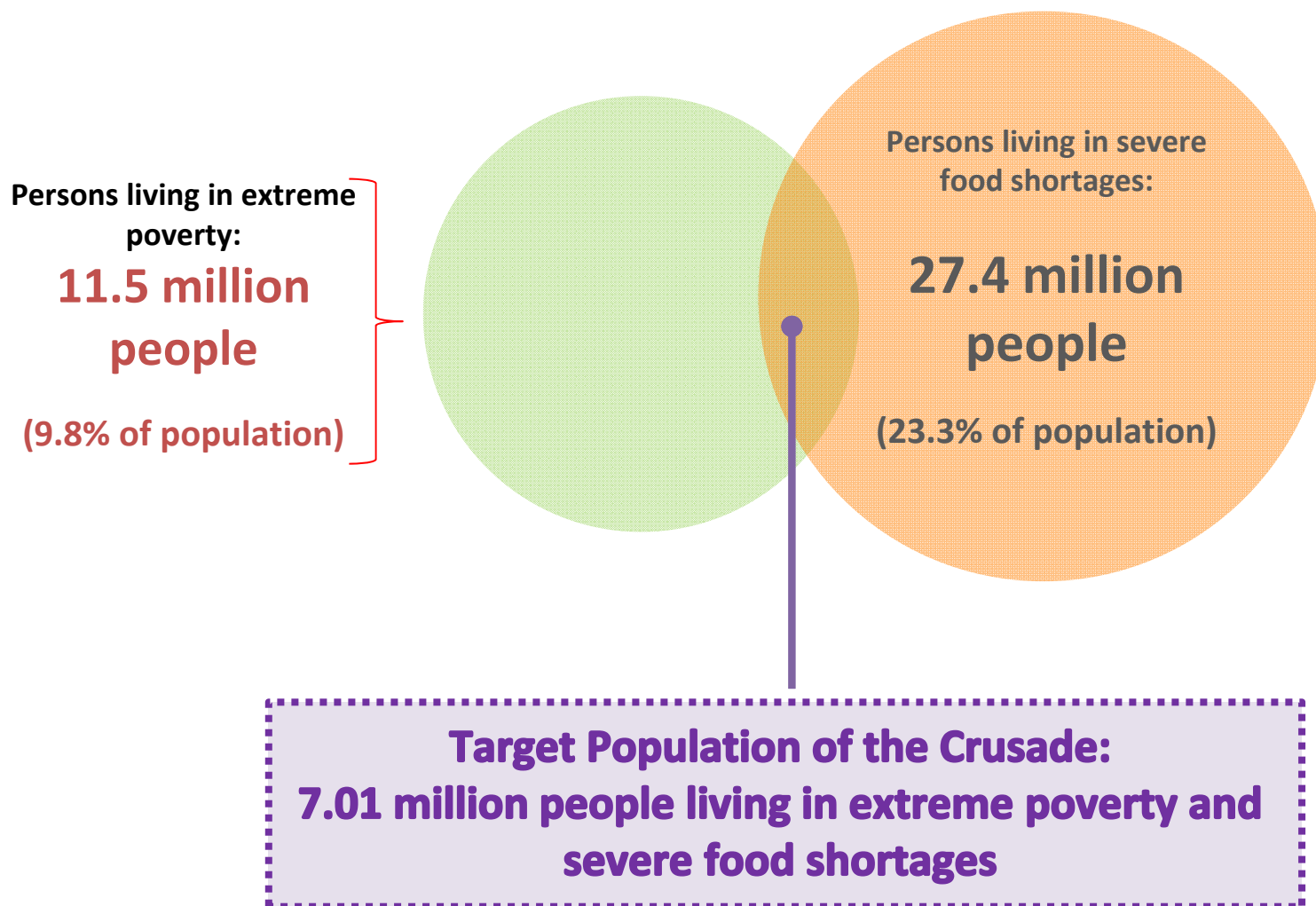
Identifying population in poverty

- “A person is considered to be in multidimensional poverty when she/he has at least one social deprivation and insufficient income to satisfy its needs”.

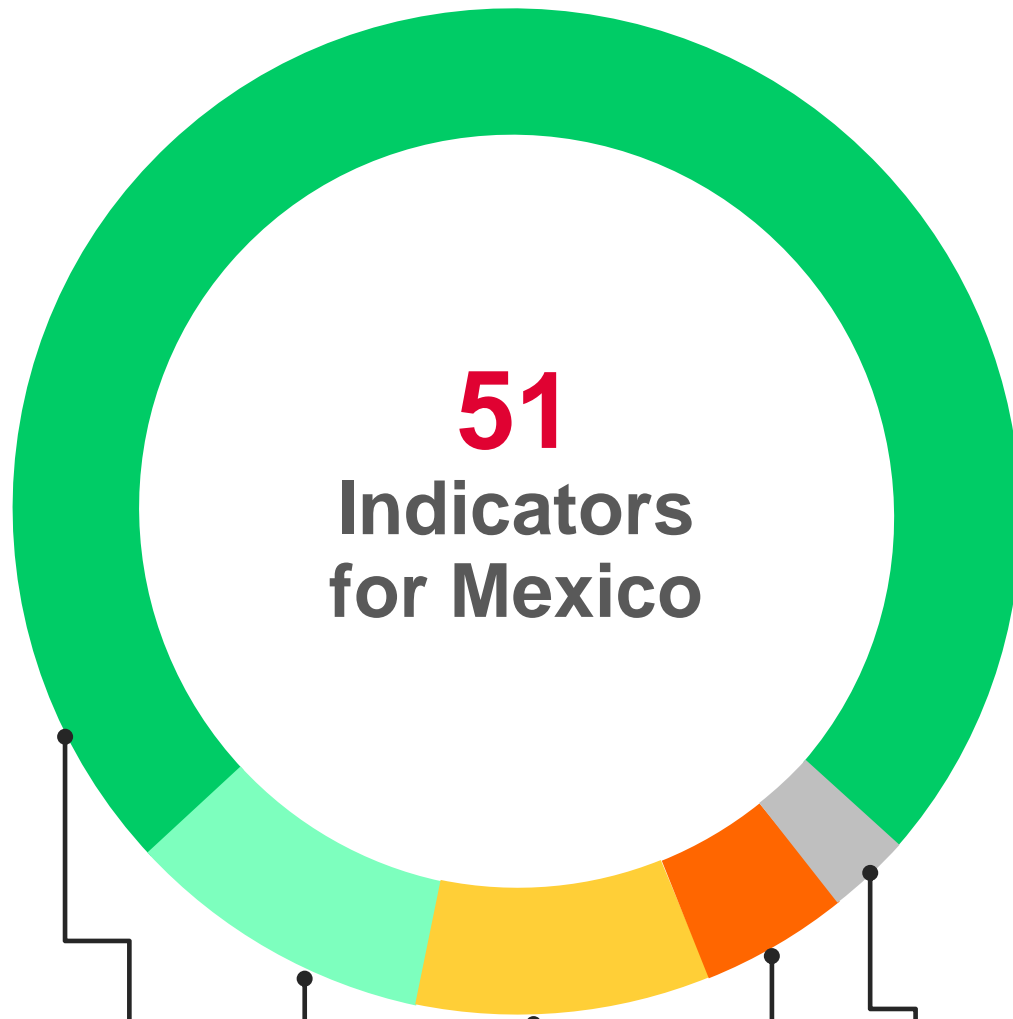




Target Population of the National Crusade Against Hunger
