






Indigenous population as % of total population. Mexico, 2010



Identifying population in poverty

- The Methodology for **Multidimensional Poverty Index in Mexico** considers two main features: social rights and economic wellbeing.
- "A person is considered to be in multidimensional poverty when she/he has at least one social deprivation and insufficient income to satisfy its needs".







Target Population of the National Crusade Against Hunger

Persons living in extreme poverty:

11.5 million people


(9.8% of population)

Persons living in severe food shortages:

27.4 million people

(23.3% of population)

Target Population of the Crusade:
